FROM THE EDITOR



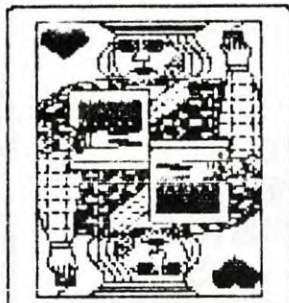
