### ANOTHER YEAR GONE BY

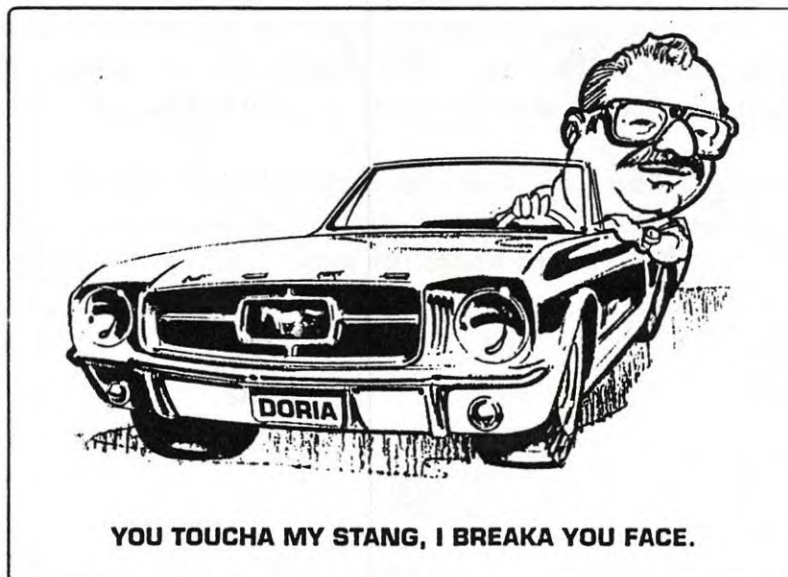
