1971 Mustang "Sports" Hardtop

We ordered our Wimbledon white Mustang on 4/30/71 with the very rare "Sports" Spring Special Option Package A (only about 500 were made due to a short promo period and almost no publicity). It included Wide Oval fiberglass belted tires, "dog dish" hubcaps with trim rings, color keyed urethane front bumper, Mach I style grille, NASA hood, dual sport mirrors, lower body-side black paint, and black Boss 351-style "hockey stick" side stripes ...basically a Mach I, but a hardtop with a trunk and better rear vision that we wanted for daily family use. There was also an Option Package B that included everything of the A, but with Magnum 500 wheels. On 5/20/71, we paid **\$2900.00 plus \$116.00 tax** to Jack Griffin Ford in Waukesha ...almost a half year's gross pay for me back then. Our now 100,000-mile plus pony still has its **original interior and exterior**, except for normal maintenance. Even the "Ford Mustang" floor mats are original! After five years of limited daily use, it became a babied garage queen that **never** got rusted out, or in a bad collision.

As time passed, I wanted more giddy-up-and-go, so performance modifications evolved into a hobby, but always with the goal of keeping a stock looking "driver" with over 450 HP. I made modifications and changes to just about everything you can't see with the hood closed as both ideas came and "hobby money" was available.

Our old horse is a well-behaved driver that feeds on 93 octane pump gas and typically gets 15-16 MPG when driven like the oldie it is. But let the reigns out at W.O.T. between 3000 and 7000 RPM, it gets a bit thirsty, but is a fun ride ...especially around its peak HP at 5900 RPM! It isn't the greatest or most valuable collector car, but it holds so many memories throughout much of our adult lives, and we still love it.

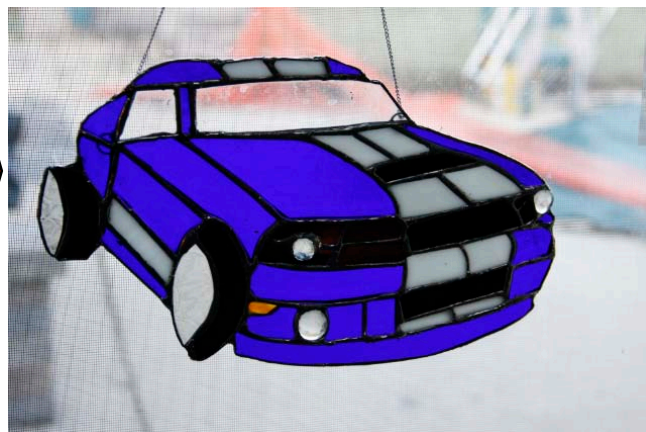

- ★ -1995 was the final model year for the 5.0 liter V8, which began life as the 260cid and later 289 cid engine. The second bare bones SVT Cobra R was introduced with
- ★ -In 1996, for the first time the Mustang GTs and SVT Mustang Cobras were equipped with 4.6 liter Dual Overhead Cam (DOHC) V8, producing 305 horsepower
- ★ -Ford's Passive Anti Theft System became standard on all models in 1997.
- ★ -In 1998 the output of Mustang GT's 4.6 liter V8 was increased to 225 horsepower.
