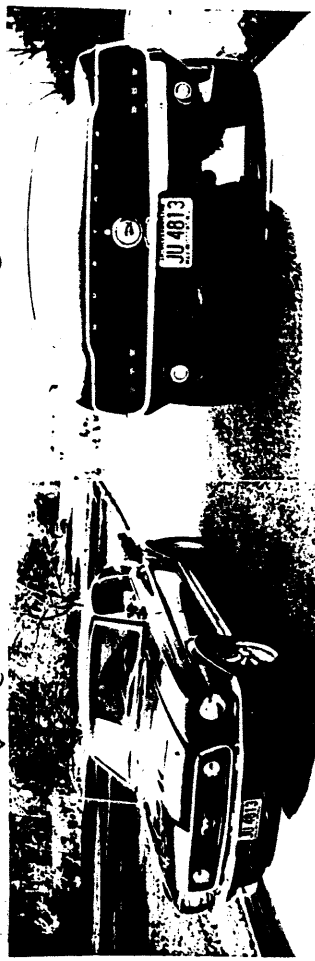

Steve and Jim are looking for people interested in running down at the Grove for Ford Day on April 23. Any of you out there game?

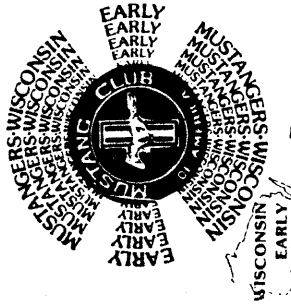


Steve's '73 convertible

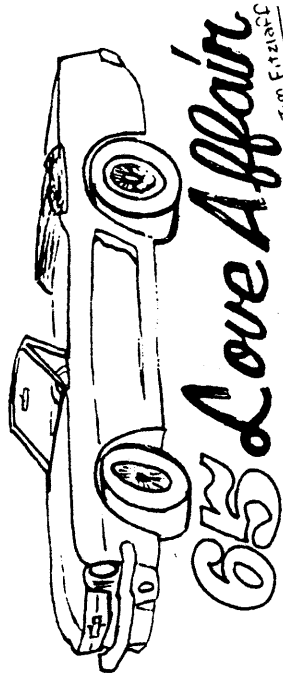
