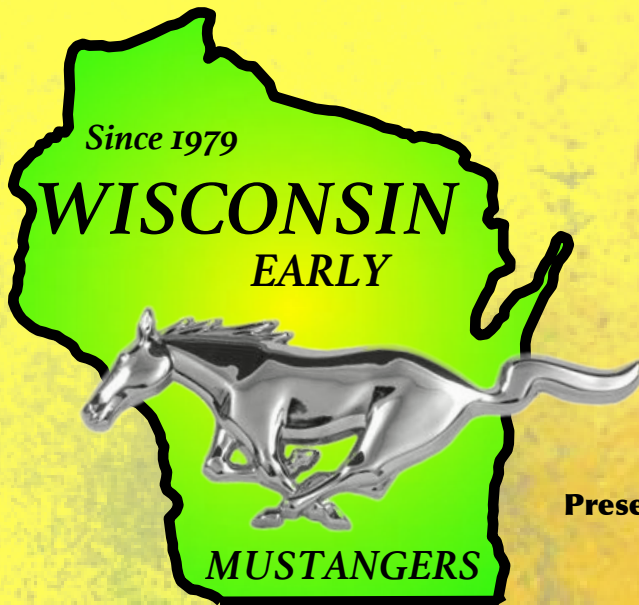

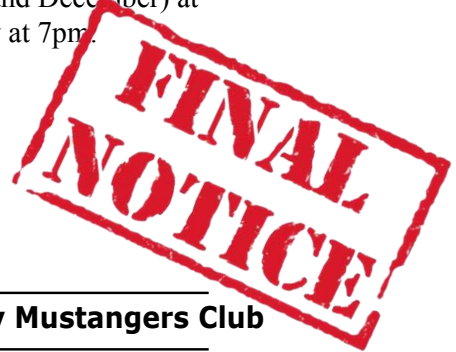


The Wisconsin Early Mustangers invite you to join!
