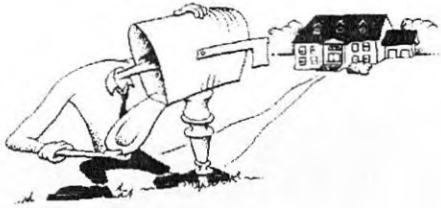

## *From Your Editor*

### *1998 Car Show*

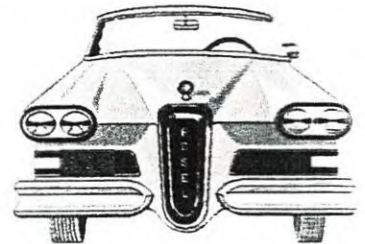
