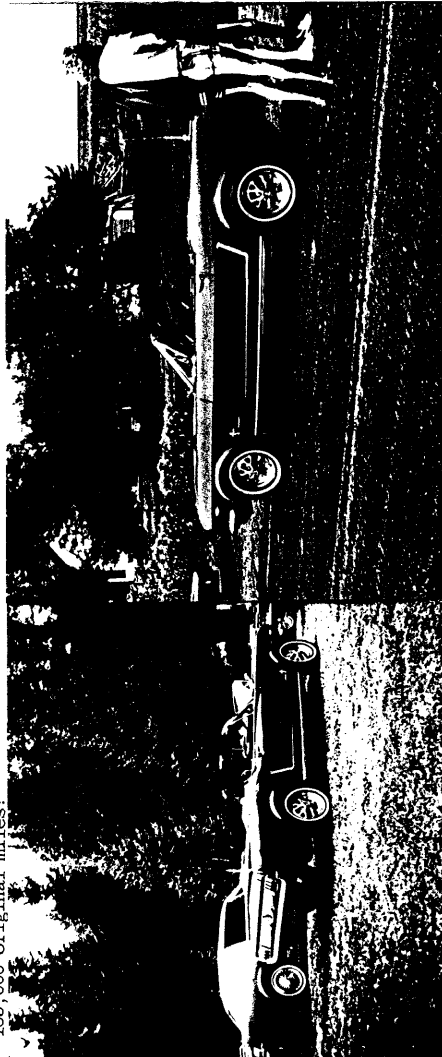


"CAR OF THE MONTH"

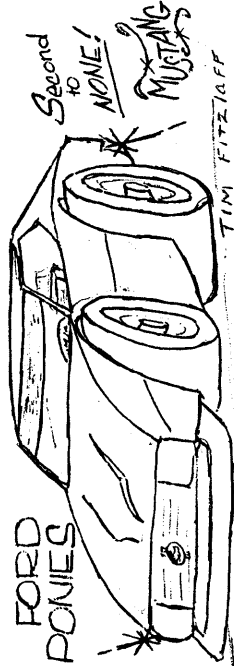

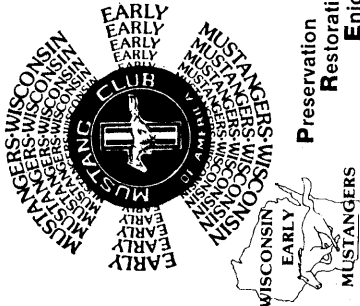


OWNER: Dick Doria - '65 Convertible - (Alias "Sunkist")
