The following is the itinerary which will be followed during the 13 weeks:

- WEEK 1 "THE PLAN": Things to consider before starting a restoration project.
- WEEK 2 "FINDING THE CAR": What to look for in a project car.
- WEEK 3 "FIX OR REPLACE": How to catalogue parts, & where to get new and used parts.
- WEEK 4 "PARTS AND TOOLS": A variety of air tools and restoration tools are reviewed.
- WEEK 5 "PAINT STRIPPING": How to safely use strippers for paint removal.
- WEEK 6 "METAL CUTTING": Removal of rust damaged body parts, repairing minor dents.
- WEEK 7 "PANEL FITTING": Panels are fitted to the car for welding in place.
- WEEK 8 "WELDING": Structural strength and the importance of welding patches for appearance.
- WEEK 9 "PLASTIC FILLING": Dent removal using various fillers are explained.
- WEEK 10 "PRIMING & SANDING": Preparation work for painting, paint mixing.
- WEEK 11 "PAINTING": A state of the art auto body and paint shop is visited.
- WEEK 12 "CLEAN, BUFF & TOUCH UP": Machine buffing with rubbing compounds is demonstrated.
- WEEK 13 "FINAL ASSEMBLY": Putting it all back together and detailing.

This series will be well worth video taping. The 13 (1/2 hour) segments should fit on one extended play video tape. The details of the air time will be passed on to you when I receive them.

# THE WISCONSIN EARLY MUSTANGERS

## BY LAWS

1. The group shall be known as The Wisconsin Early Mustangers.
2. Members of the group are responsible for their individual actions as part of the group.
3. Meetings to be held monthly with the exception of December. Place of meeting to be Wauwatosa S & L, Tri City office. Meetings held on the last Monday of each month except May. May meetings held on the second last Monday of the Month.
4. Meeting shall follow reasonable form of parliamentary procedure. Majority vote of attending members to decide major issues.
5. Election of officers to be held each four years, during the November meeting of the last year in office. Nominations will be stated at the October meeting of that year. Exception only in case of resignation, moving, death or impeachment. In those cases a replacement will be voted on at the next regular meeting.
6. The basic Board of Directors shall consist of thirteen members. The Charter officers shall retain their positions on the board. The President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer shall have a seat on the board at all times. In addition the following committee positions shall be filled as board seats.

Picnic  
Ways and Means  
Show/Swap

Special events  
Technical  
Communication

7. The committee chairperson seats on the Board shall be chosen by election at the first regular meeting upon installation of the officers starting a new term.
8. Dues shall be \$15.00 (American) per year. Due and Payable on January 1st of each year. New members starting January through August renew the next January. New members September through December renew the January after next.

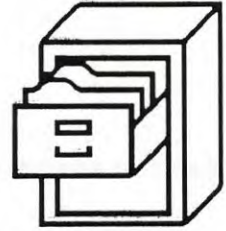
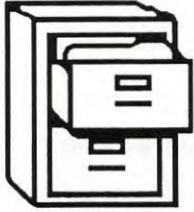

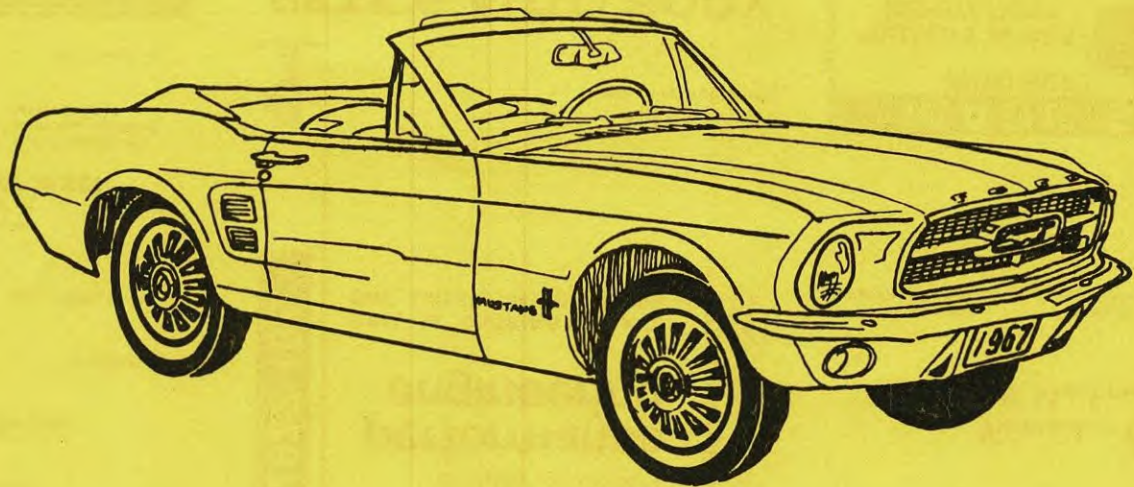
