July 4, 1998

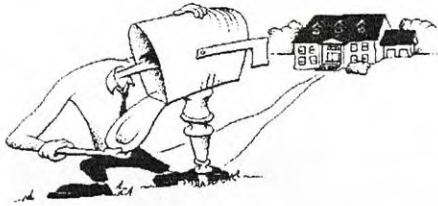
Well I hope everyone had a fun and safe 4th of July. I've got a bit to cover in this month so I'll get right into it.

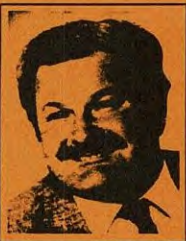
