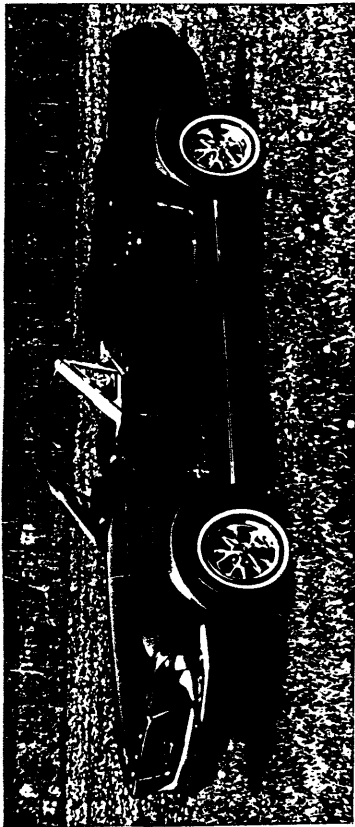


CAR OF THE MONTH

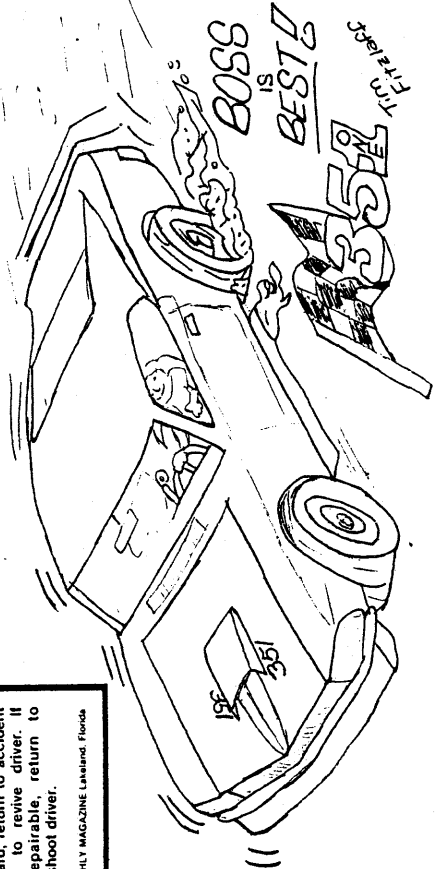
MEDIC ALERT
