Another special note is that the Door County trip had to be moved back one week to Oct. 20th - Oct. 22nd.

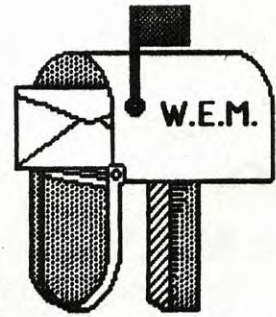
Got to hit the road back to Naperville, 11 before midnight. Keep in touch, hope to see you at our events. And as always.

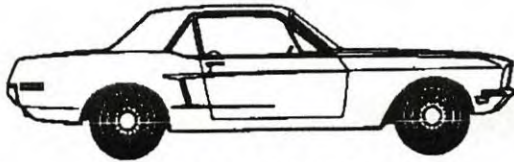
MINUTES FROM JULY 31, 1989 MEETING

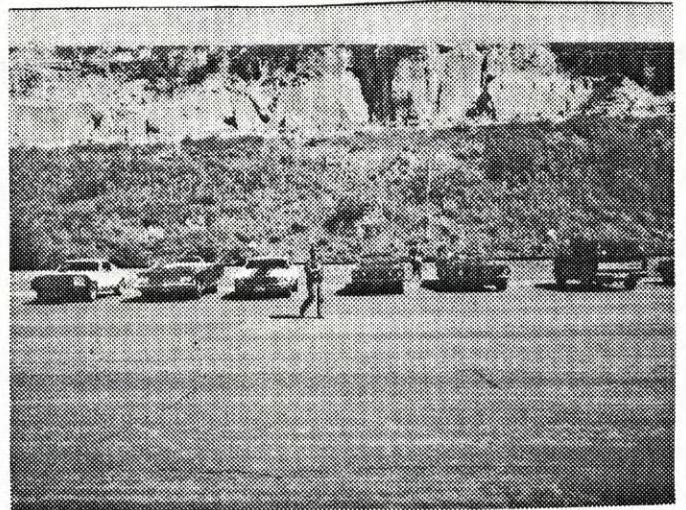
