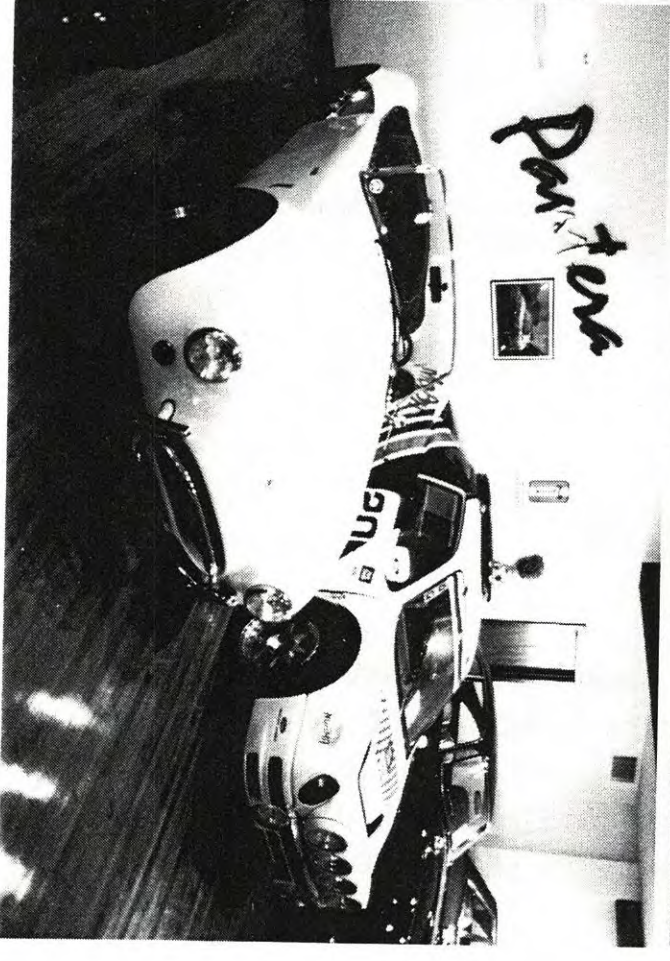
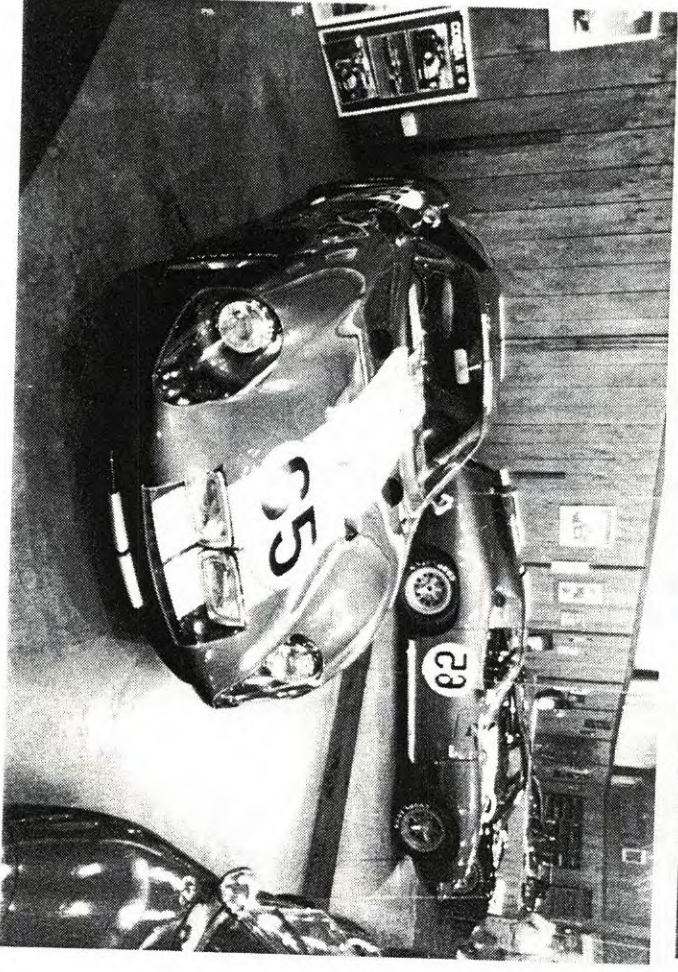
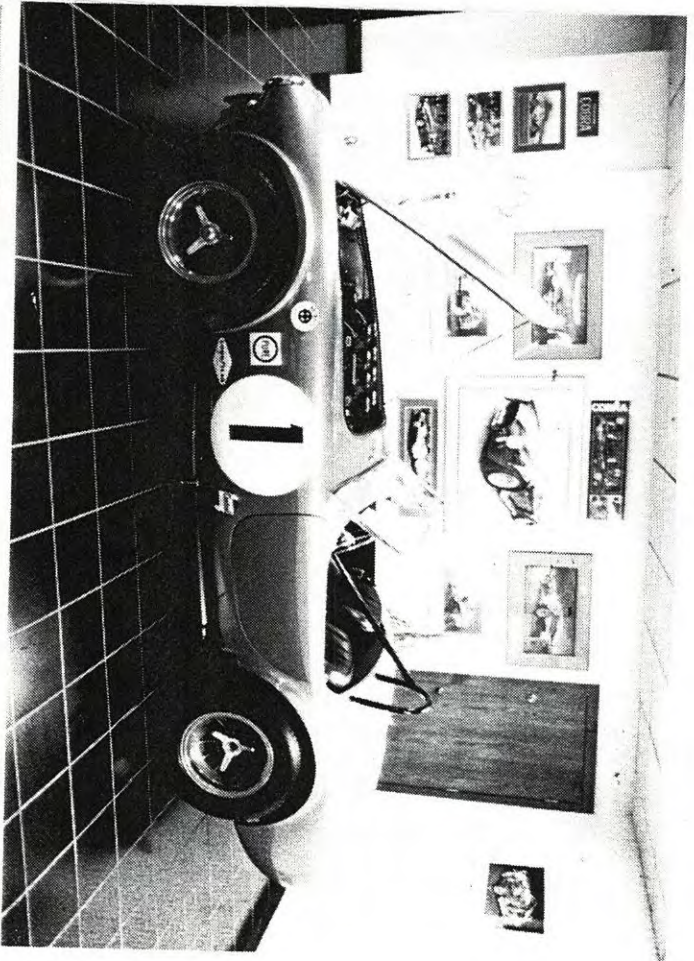
MINUTES FROM MEETING HELD JULY 26

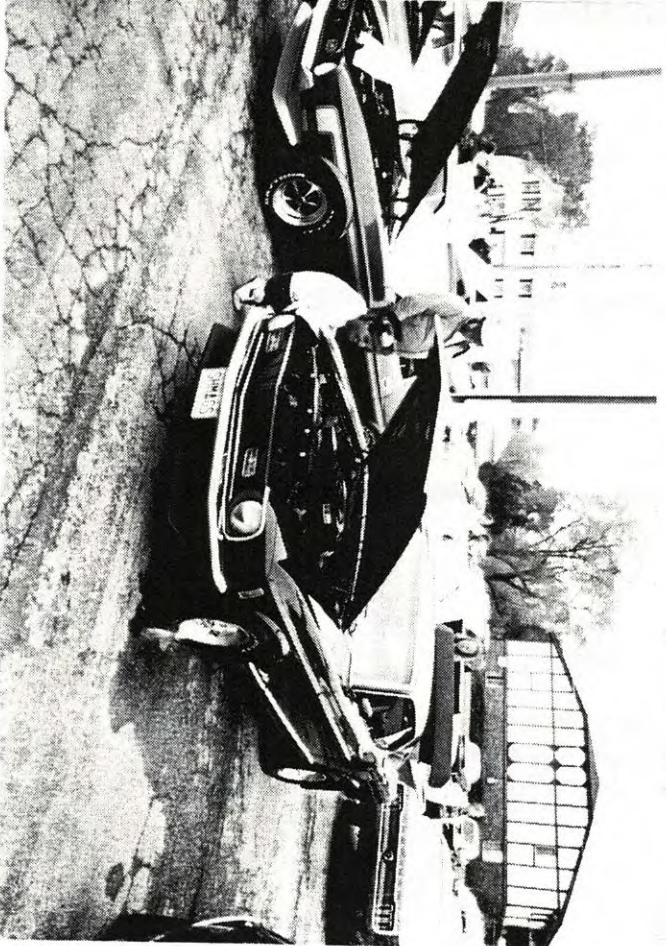

Detroit in September

Hi, Everyone!

Plans are well underway for the Over-The-Road Trip to Detroit and Dearborn, MI, area being planned for the Wisconsin Early Mustangers and the Midwest Ford Club. We will be leaving on Thursday, September 23, 1993, and returning on Sunday, September 26, 1993.

While in Detroit, we'll be staying at the Red Roof Inn in Plymouth, MI, where a block of 25 rooms is being held for us. A single room (one double bed) for two people will cost \$34.99 plus tax per night, and a double room (two double beds) will cost \$42.99 plus tax per night. Each of you needs to make your own room reservation by calling 1-800/874-9000 and asking for a reservation under #016000015 for Midwest Ford Club. These rooms will be held only until September 13, 1993, so it's best to get your reservations early.

Due to a change in policy, we will be unable to take a tour of the Ford plant in Wixom. They only allow 20 people to tour the plant per week. Oh, well, we'll just have to find something else to do on Friday. Right now, we're looking into some other things such as a tour of the Edsel Ford mansion or maybe a quick trip across the river to Canada. We'll have more on that later.

On Thursday night we'll be having dinner at the Henry Ford Mansion with a tour afterward. Cost of the turkey and dressing dinner and private tour is \$25.00 per person, and must be paid by September 1, 1993. Send your check or money order with the correct amount made out to Midwest Ford Club to 2721 Gilboa Avenue, Zion, IL 60099-2421.

We'll visit the Henry Ford Institute and Museum and Greenfield Village on Saturday. Cost of going through the Institute and Museum is \$16.50 per person and to tour Greenfield Village is also \$16.50 person.
