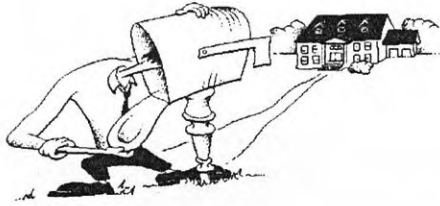
THE FEEDBAG
