Hi Everyone,

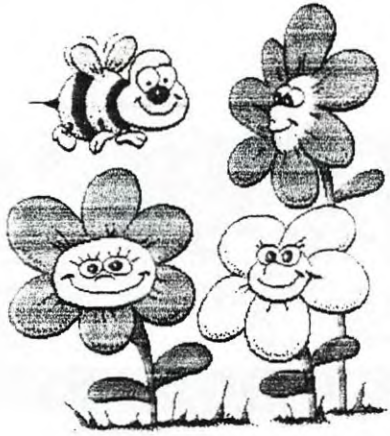

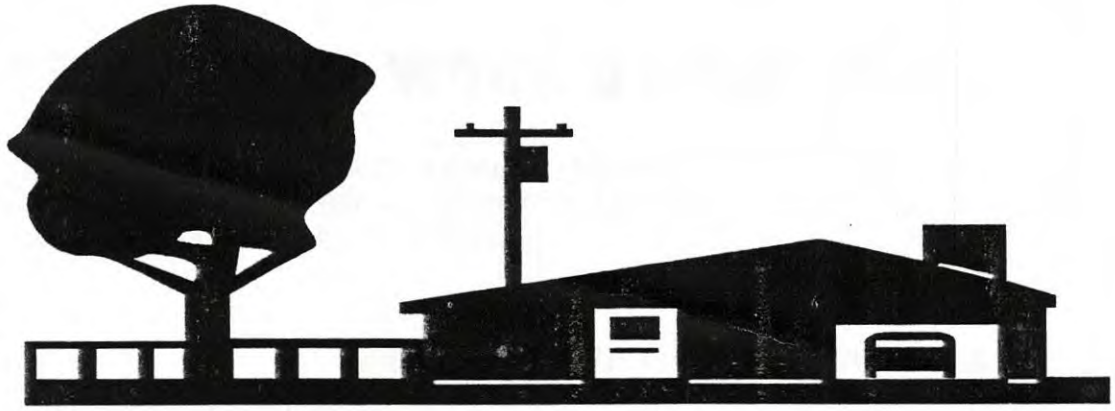
