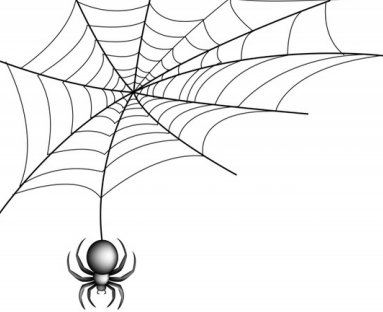

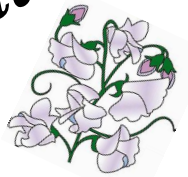

Here Comes Sweet Pea



Meet Sweet Pea our Wimbledon White 1967 Mustang coupe who became part of our family in August of 2008. She was born on September 26, 1966 at the now closed Ford Assembly Plant in San Jose, CA. delivered to and sold from Sun Valley Ford in Concord, CA. The Marti report shows 472,209, 1967 Mustangs were built. Of those only 58 coupes, with a 289 engine and an automatic transmission were built with Ivy Gold bucket seats and deluxe interior. Only 1 came with a wood steering wheel. The plan is to keep her pretty much original.

She lived most of her life in the Reno, Nevada area, and luckily never saw snow. We purchased her from a couple in North Prairie. The husband flew to his parents in Reno and drove Sweet Pea, who named her, back to Wisconsin. Sweet Pea was a college graduation gift for his wife who always wanted a Mustang and didn't know her in-laws had one. Their family enjoyed the car for several years before selling it to pay for college expenses. They also kept her stored for the winter.

We are very proud that in June of 2014 Sweet Pea was invited to the Eyes in Design Automotive Design Car Show. We drove her to the show at the Edsel and Eleanor Ford House in Grosse Pointe Shores, Michigan. The show had invited a Mustang from each year from the Mustang prototype through the 2014. Sweet Pea was selected to represent 1967. We were honored to be selected. Her last big trip was in November 1017 to the AmeriCarna Live Car Show in Davidson, North Carolina. A huge car show for a great cause and a reason to spend time with our daughter, son-in-law and grandchildren who live in only 20 minutes away.

Just like the two of us she getting old and creaks a bit but we love her.

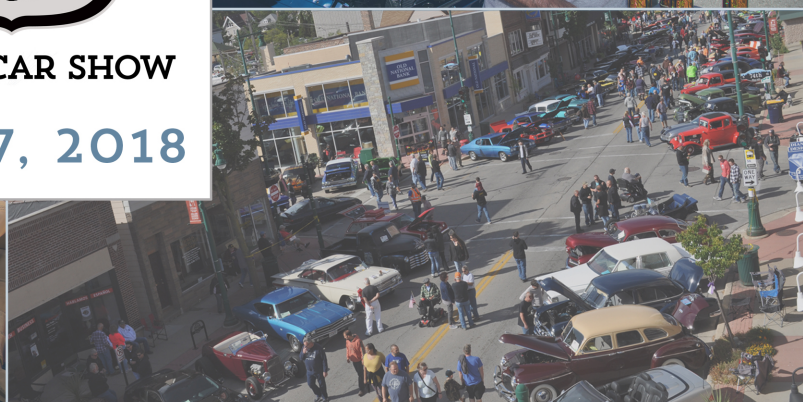
