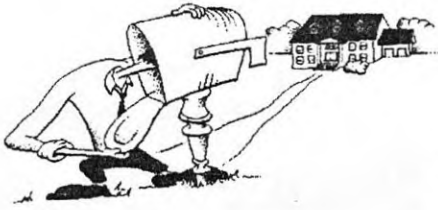

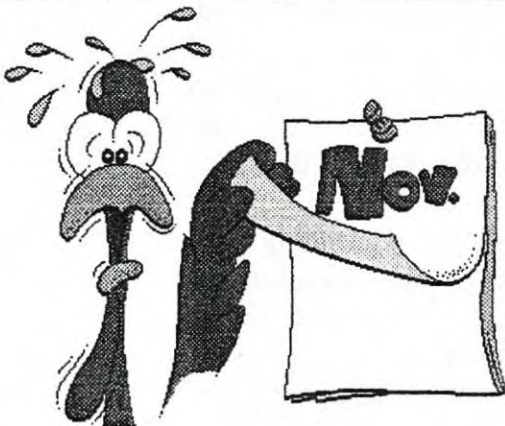
### DUES RENEWAL

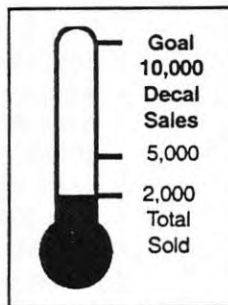
immediate response of an enthusiastic "Yes! We're interested", and a twenty-sixth city appealing to the Board, asking if it too could be considered!
