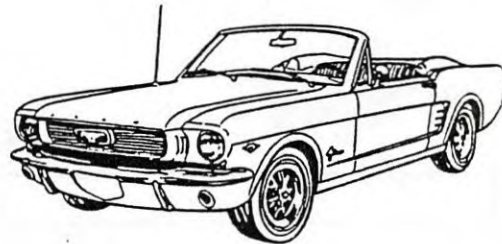

Wisconsin Early Mustangers Club Survey

1993 MUSTANG GT

My 1993 GT is my fifth Mustang. I ordered it on July 9th, 1992 and took delivery on August 27, 1992. It was amazing to me that although there was literally 20 years of evolution between the GT and my previous Mustang (a 1973 Mach 1 - "Pegasus"), it didn't feel significantly different to drive. Yes, the GT has a kidney jarring suspension and handles like a dream, but how it feels to be behind the wheel is essentially the same. The color, Reef Blue, is a 1993 only, Mustang only color. It has approx. 32,000 miles on it and is stored from November 15th to April 15th. Other than these months, it lives on the street (our one-stall garage is for my wife's 1969 custom Grandé). It is very tough keeping the GT looking good without the protection of a garage.

The GT was my college graduation present to myself. I earned it after 5 years of hard work. I ordered every available option with 3 exceptions: no leather, no CD player and no engine block heater. I have since upgraded to the factory CD player through a factory-sponsored upgrade program. I have made some necessary and some not so necessary modifications as well: a state of the art alarm system, tinted windows, glass etched with serial numbers, American Thunder cat-back system, Splitfire plugs, K&N filter, advanced base timing to 13° BTDC, and most importantly, a Kenny Brown chassis stiffening kit with weld-in subframe connectors. There is little if any body flex remaining.

I've shown this car since she was around 9 months "old". Since then, I have won about a half-dozen trophies, including one first place in August of 1994. The class was 1974-1994 Mustangs (all). I also received an Award of Excellence at the 30th Anniversary Celebration in Charlotte, NC. President Clinton autographed my dash card and my wife has since built a replica of his 1967 convertible for him, for which she received a personal thank-you note on White House stationary.

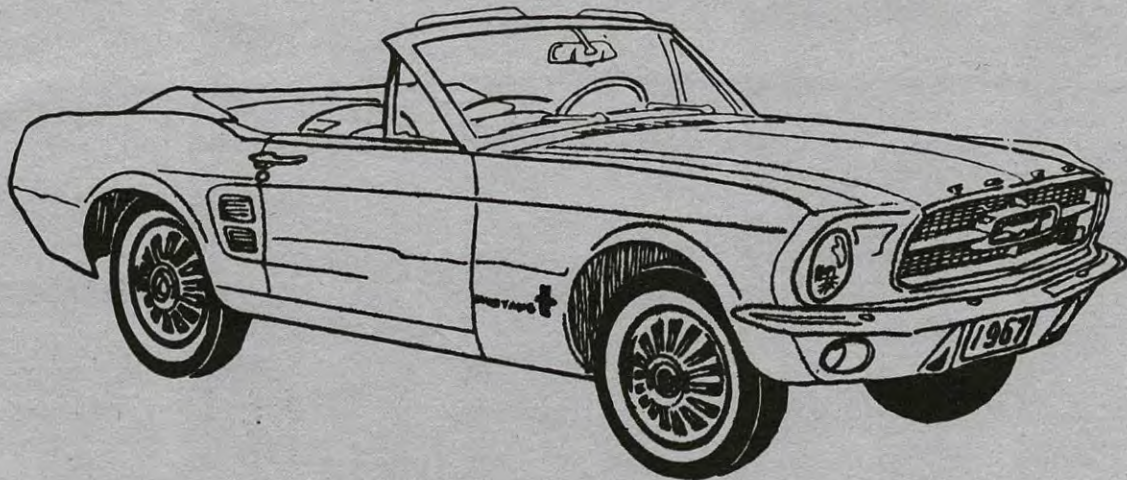
