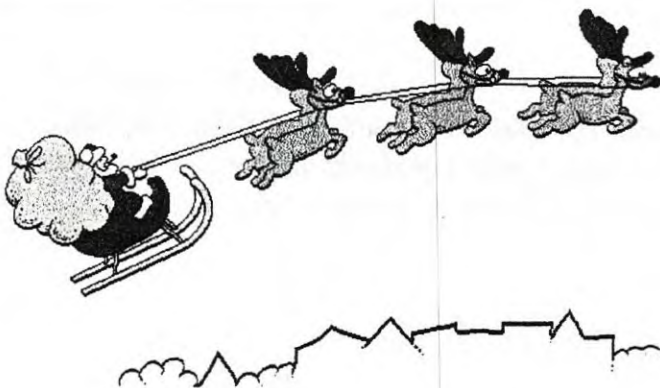
Annual Dues

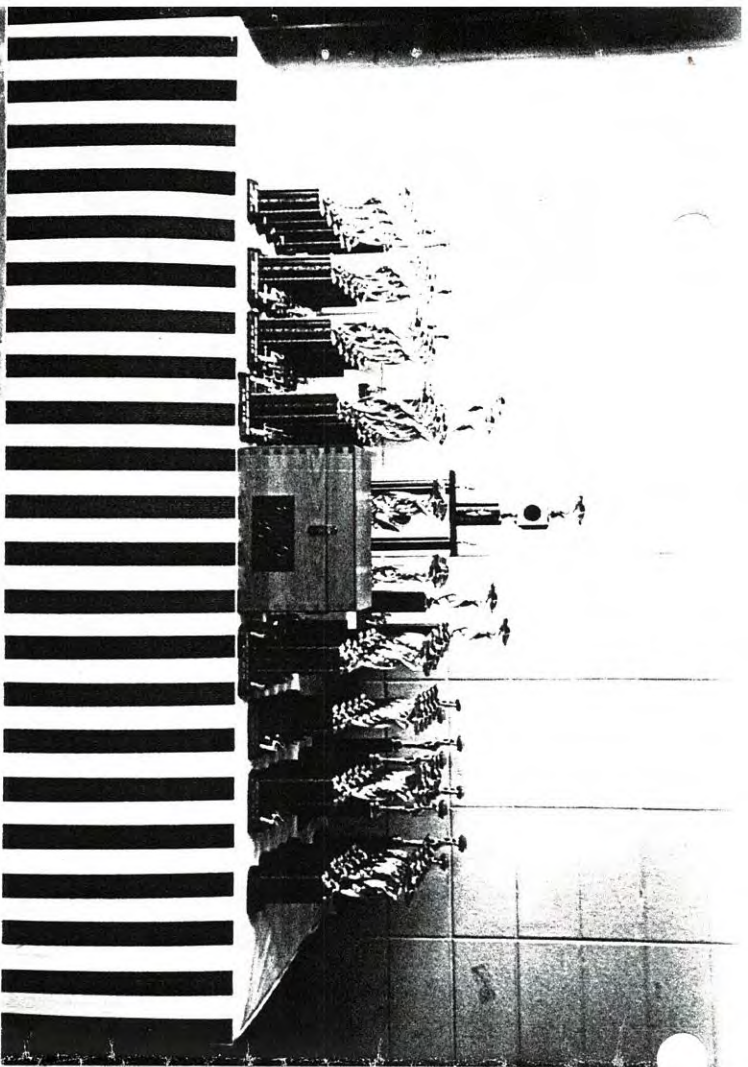
