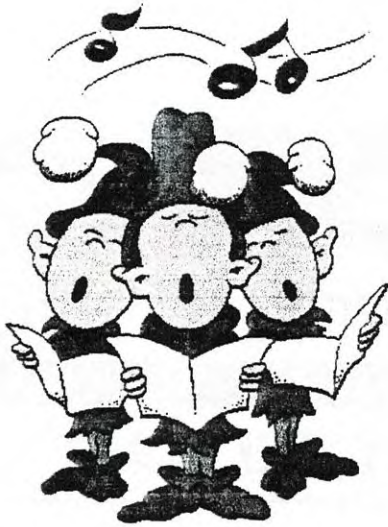
Hi Everyone,
