Winter storage tips

Typically when I put my Mustangs away for the winter there are a number of things I like to do before storing them. Here's a list of them:

- 1) Fill the gas tank preferably with non-ethanol fuel. The alcohol attracts water that rots out the gas tanks and fuel lines. It doesn't do the carburetor any good either. Being you live in Milwaukee, you will need to buy E-0 gas out in Walworth, Jefferson or other counties that can sell it. Go to www.pure-gas.org for locations.
- 2) Put Sta-bil or Seafoam in the tank. I usually use a double concentration for winter storage. Run the engine to get the mix through the fuel system.
- 3) I would recommend the storage unit you park the car in for the winter has a concrete floor. A soil / gravel floor may allow unwanted moisture to sit under the car. Not cool.
- 4) Make sure the car is clean before putting a good car cover over it.
- 5) I typically toss a number of dryer sheets in the trunk, passenger compartment to help keep rodents out. (Dryer sheets smell better than moth balls)
- 6) Be sure your window washer antifreeze solution is good for cold Wisconsin winters.
- 7) Make sure you have a proper engine coolant antifreeze for the winter.
- 8) I usually disconnect the negative battery cable from the battery. Helps reduce battery drain. Check the battery's water level, if the battery is one that you can check. It's also a good idea to be sure the battery is fully charged before storage. I put a battery maintenance charger on it once in a while over the winter. I have a Deltran Battery Tender for that.
- 9) I put a boot tray under the oil pan / transmission in case of an occasional drip. Keeps the garage floor clean(er).

Additionally:

- A) Some people also put a plastic tarp down on a concrete floor before driving the car into its stall. It's been said that even concrete allows moisture to sneak through.
- B) Some people put the car up on stands or wheel dollies. I put a piece of plywood under each of the tires. I think this helps prevent the tires from developing flat spots.
- C) Some people put stainless-steel wool in the exhaust pipes to keep rodents out. Doesn't hurt to do this. If you start the car with it in there, it will just blow it out.
- D) Try to pick a storage area that has good ventilation, or is climate-controlled. Ventilation is important to keep condensation at bay. Most storage places are pretty well ventilated. Climate-controlled storage is expensive, but the best. Good cold storage will probably cost you \$350-700 for the season.
