

The Problem With Aft ?

Is there really an advantage to using nitrogen rather than air in car tires, such as better fuel economy, a smoother ride, or longer tire life? Air is 78 percent nitrogen and just under 21 percent oxygen, and the rest is water vapor, CO2, and small concentrations of noble gases such as neon and argon which have little impact in tire pressure.

There are several good reasons to use pure nitrogen in tires. First is that nitrogen is less likely to migrate through tire rubber than is oxygen, which means that your

tire pressures will remain more stable over the long term. Racers figured

out pretty quickly that tires filled with nitrogen rather than air also

exhibit less pressure change with temperature swings. That

means more consistent inflation pressures during a race as

the tires heat up.

Passenger cars can also benefit from the more stable pressures. Humidity (water) is a bad thing to have inside a tire. Water, present as a vapor or even as a liquid in a tire, causes more of a pressure change with temperature swings than dry air does. It also promotes corrosion of the steel or aluminum rim and can damage todays tire pressure sensors (TPS).

Any system that delivers pure nitrogen is also going to deliver dry nitrogen. Filling tires with nitrogen involves filling and purging several times in succession, diluting the concentration of oxygen in the tire. This will also remove any water.


With nitrogen, your tire pressures will remain more constant, saving you a small amount in fuel and tire-maintenance costs. There will be less moisture inside your tires, meaning less corrosion on your wheels. Tires were filled with nitrogen generally have green valve-stem caps.


Nitrogen is no substitute for proactive, regular tire care and maintenance. Checking tire pressures at least once a month is a good idea, no matter what's inside.
