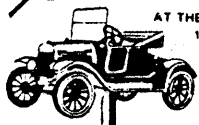

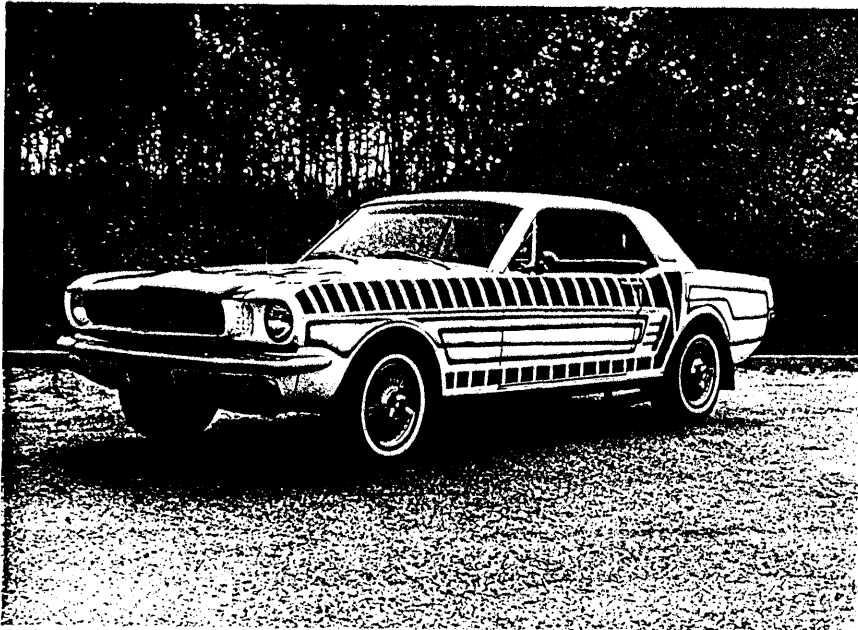
THE MEETING - JAN. 30th, 1984

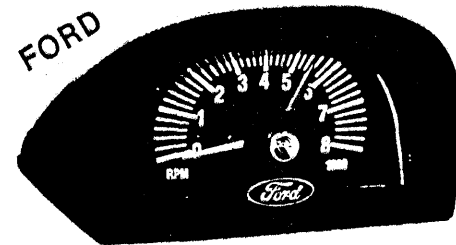
