

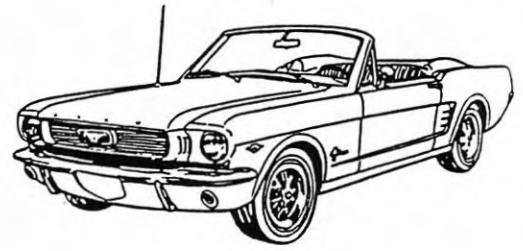

OWNERS STEVE AND KATHLEEN KLEIN

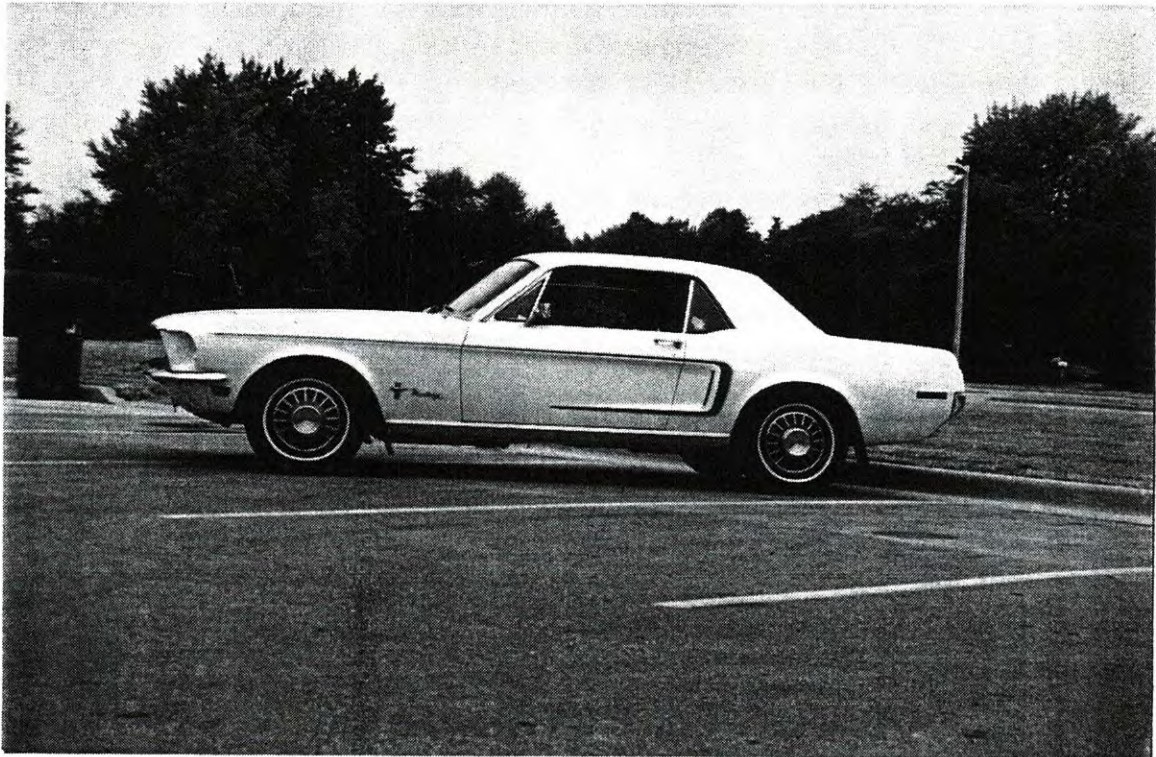
I purchased my Mustang on May 24th 1971 with 28,013 miles on the odometer. The assembly date was June, 1968. It has a 200 cubic inch 6 cylinder with automatic transmission and power steering. All of which are still original. It is Meadowlark Yellow with a black interior.

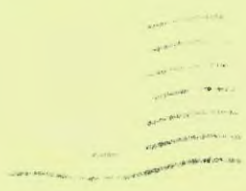
I owned the car until I got married in 1979 at which time gave it to my parents. While they owned it was rear ended by a truck. it looked like a gremlin. The trunk was pushed up to the rear window. It was repaired by Southgate Ford. My father purchased a new car in 1984 and I received the Mustang once again.

Mid 1980 I began to start the restoration project. Collins Classic Cars attempted to paint it with disastrous results. Late 1980 I took it to Pete's Auto Body for work. I had the rear suspension and underbody restored. This included sandblasting and replacing everything that needed replacing. The engine compartment was also detailed. Pete did a very good job.

A short time later I had Boucher Chevrolet, in Waukesha, strip the body to bare metal and repaint back to the original color, including striping. The also did a very good job.

Our Mustang now has 91,791 miles on her and is used only for pleasure driving in the summer. No more winter salt storms !





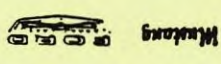
