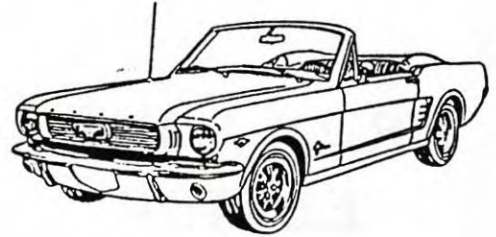

Hi Ho fellow Mustangers ! Another month down and only 3 more to go until the 10th Annual All Ford Show & Swap. It really says a lot about the club. Ten shows and still going strong. I'm sure that we'll be around for a long time to come.

For the last 3 years, I've had the good fortune to attend the Chicago Auto Show. It proves to be more interesting year to year. Ford puts on a good showing of all of their products, especially the Mustang. This year they had a black on black GT hatchback and a Calypso Green LX 5.0L Convertible. The third Mustang was one that will be available in the spring of this year. It is a special edition LX 5.0L Convertible that sports a new rear spoiler and special interior trim. The color is a bright red, and boy is it bright. It is one sharp car. Ford also took the opportunity to introduce a new high performance Mustang that will be available in the next 12 months, the Mustang Cobra. It sports a SVO equipped 5.0L that will put out approx. 275 bhp. The suspension will also be upgraded with performance pieces in use on most of the aftermarket Mustangs .. i.e. Saleen and Steeda Mustangs. Unfortunately the car was only shown to the area reps and media.

I also talked with Steven Lapp, Merchandising Manager for Ford in the Chicago Region. We talked about the Mustang Cobra and he told me that another name that he had suggested was the Mustang Boss. He is a die hard Mustanger like the rest of us. Steve told me to send him some information on our show and he would see if Ford might be interested in displaying some items at our show. Who knows what might happen !!!

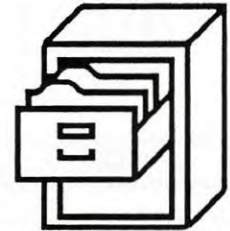

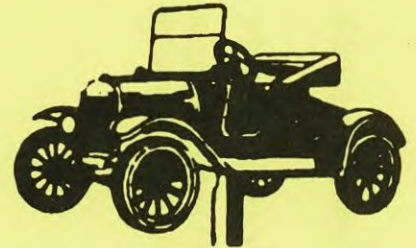

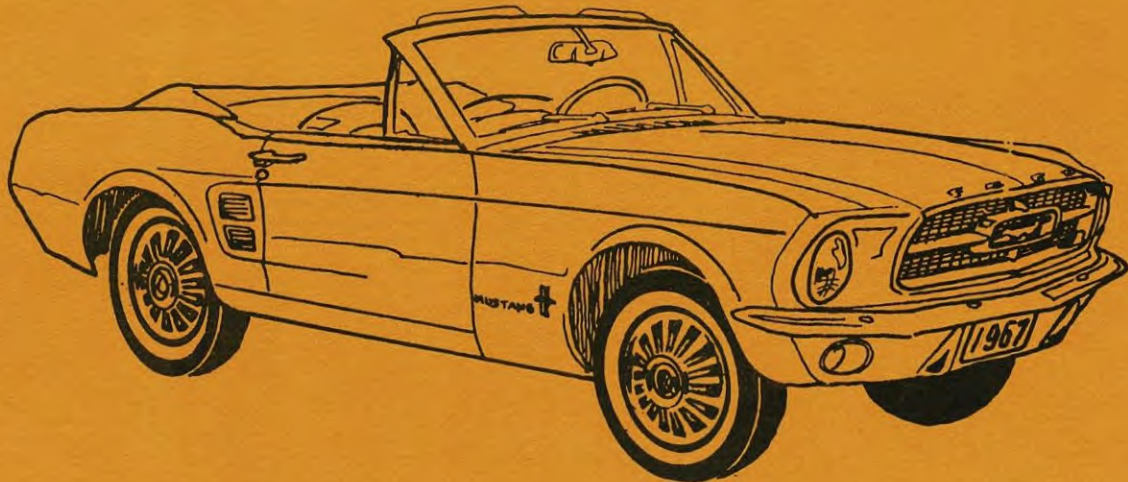
