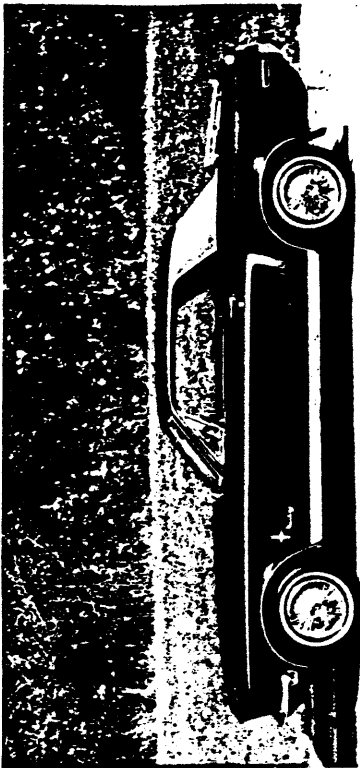


CAR OF THE MONTH

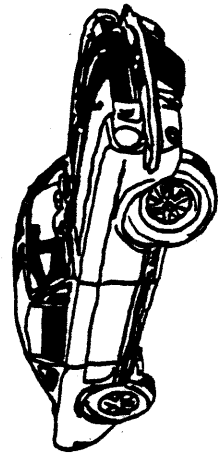

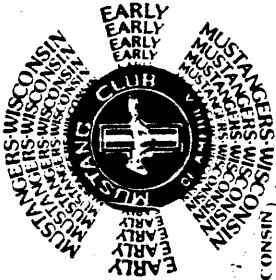
