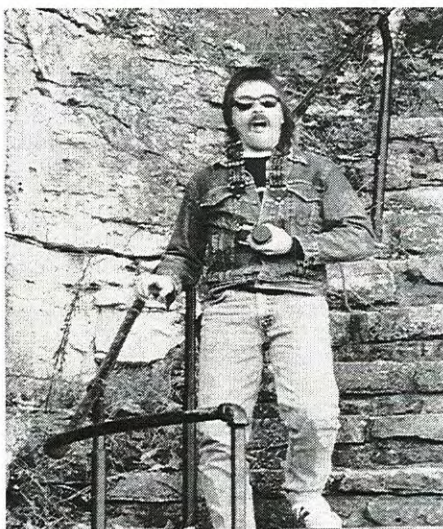
Home Improvement Syndrome Discovered !

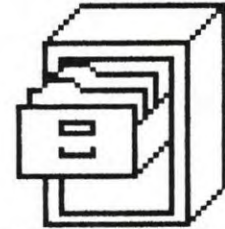
