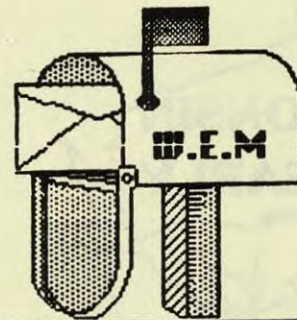

DEARBORN OVER-THE-ROAD TRIP

The Midwest Ford Club and Wisconsin Early Mustangers are planning a joint over-the-road venture to Dearborn, MI, from Thursday through Sunday, Sept. 28 to Oct. 1, 1989. While in Dearborn we'll have dinner and a private tour of the Henry Ford estate Fair Lane. Also on the agenda is a tour of the Wixom Assembly Plant (this is where Lincoln Town Cars are made). The rest of the time will be spent visiting the Ford Museum and Greenfield Village.

We have received confirmation of our request to visit the Wixom plant on Friday afternoon. This is a two-hour walking tour that's free.

For Friday night's dinner we plan to go to the Water Works. At one time this was a power house, designed and built on the Rogue River by Mr. Ford, that supplied electricity to the city of Dearborn.

Costs will include \$22.00 per person for the dinner and tour of the Ford estate; approximately \$15.50 per person for a two-day pass to the museum and Greenfield Village; motel room for three nights (this cost varies with room size and number of people in room).

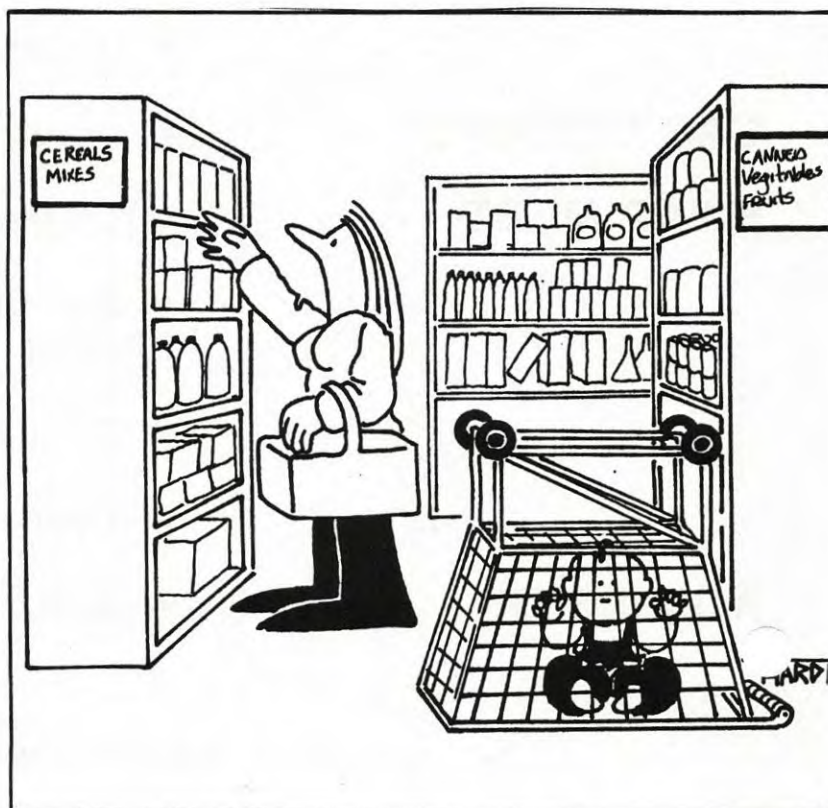

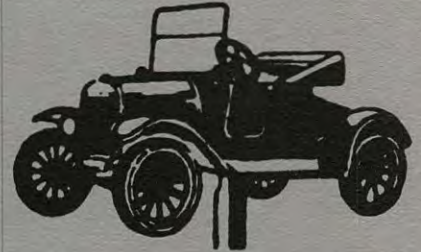

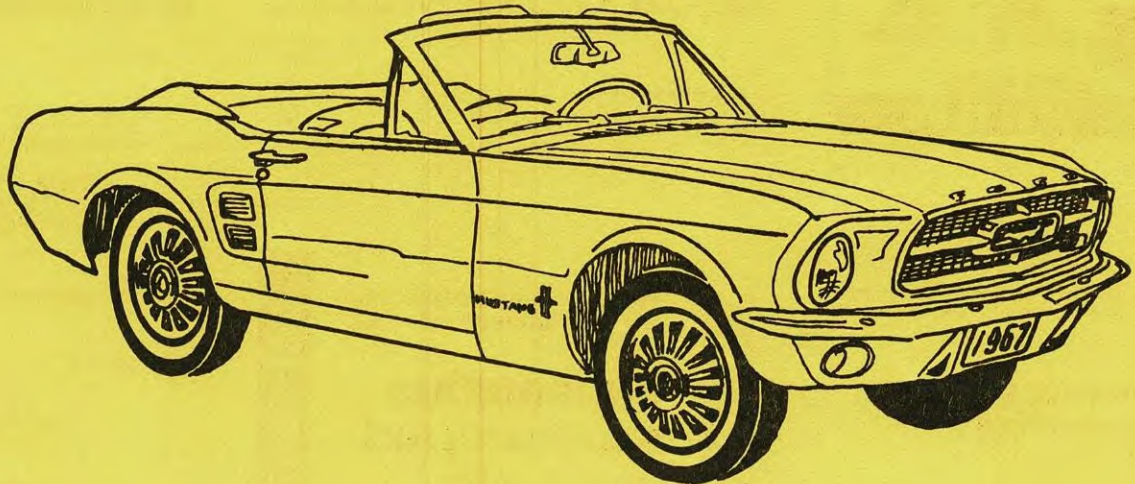
