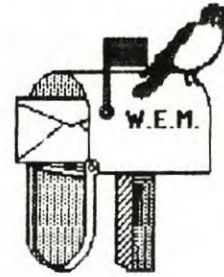

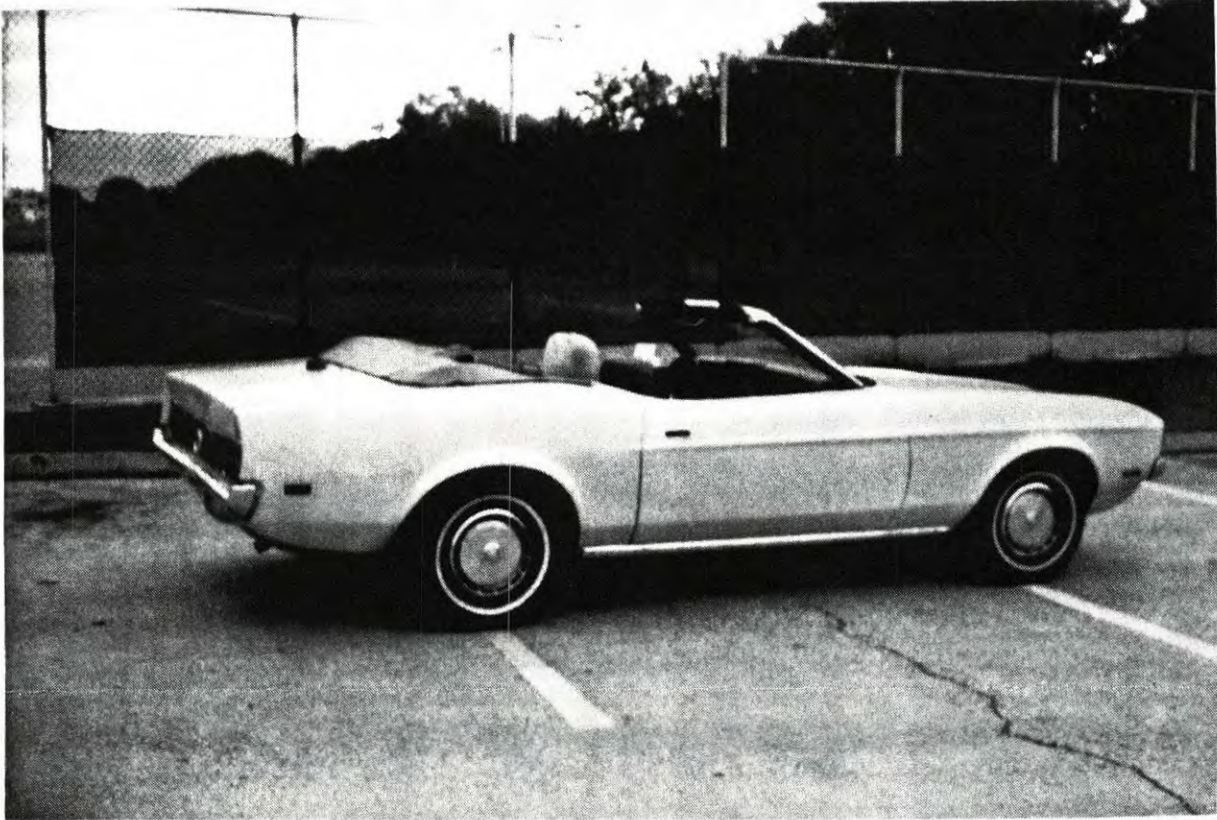
MINUTES FROM MEETING HELD MAY 21, 1990

- * The meeting was adjourned at 8:10pm.

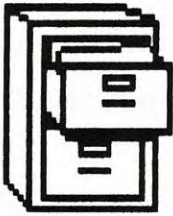


CAR OF THE MONTH

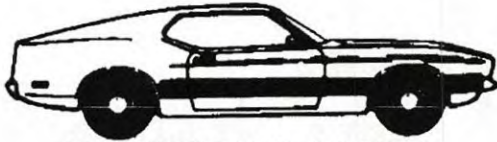

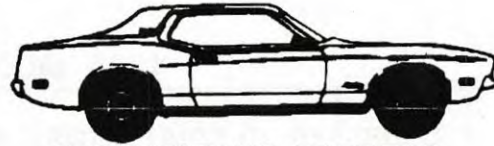

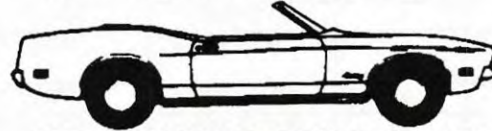
1973 MUSTANG MACH 1

1973 MUSTANG CONVERTIBLE

1973 is the last year of the so-called "first generation" Mustangs. It was also the last year for the factory-built Ford convertible.

1973 is also the first year that the Mustang suspension is tuned for radial tires as standard equipment. The "Competition Suspension" was unchanged from 1972. The "Dual Ram Air Induction" scoop was also unchanged from the previous year.

All Mustangs this year came with a urethane front bumper, color keyed to the exterior paint. But this bumper is physically different from the previous urethane bumpers. This was the first year for the government mandated impact absorbing bumpers.

The hood of the '73 is unchanged from the '72 hood, except that the front trim is always color-keyed to match the exterior paint.

A side stripe, which is identical to the 1971 Boss 351 stripe, was available in a special black argent color when the Decor group was ordered.

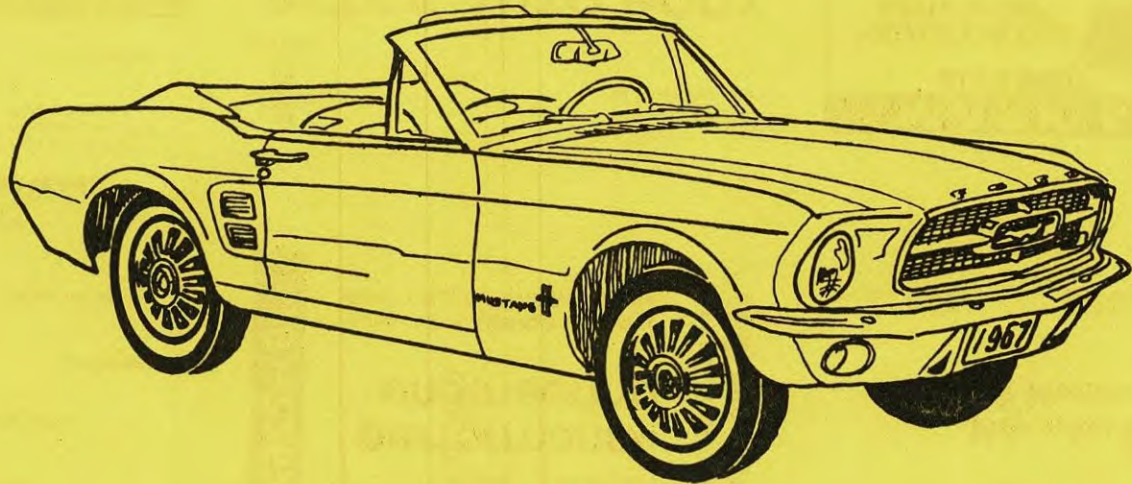
