The Milwaukee Concours car show is Aug.4-5 and will be a different format this year as all Mustangs 1974 and older will be judged as a group.

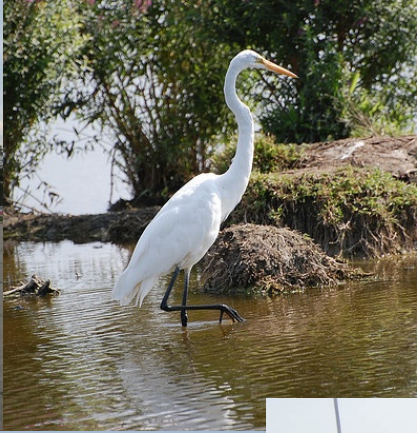

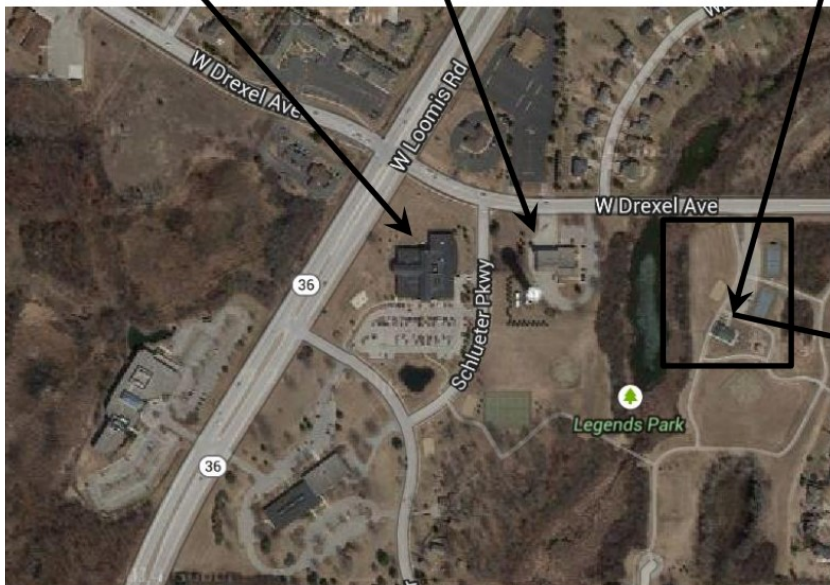

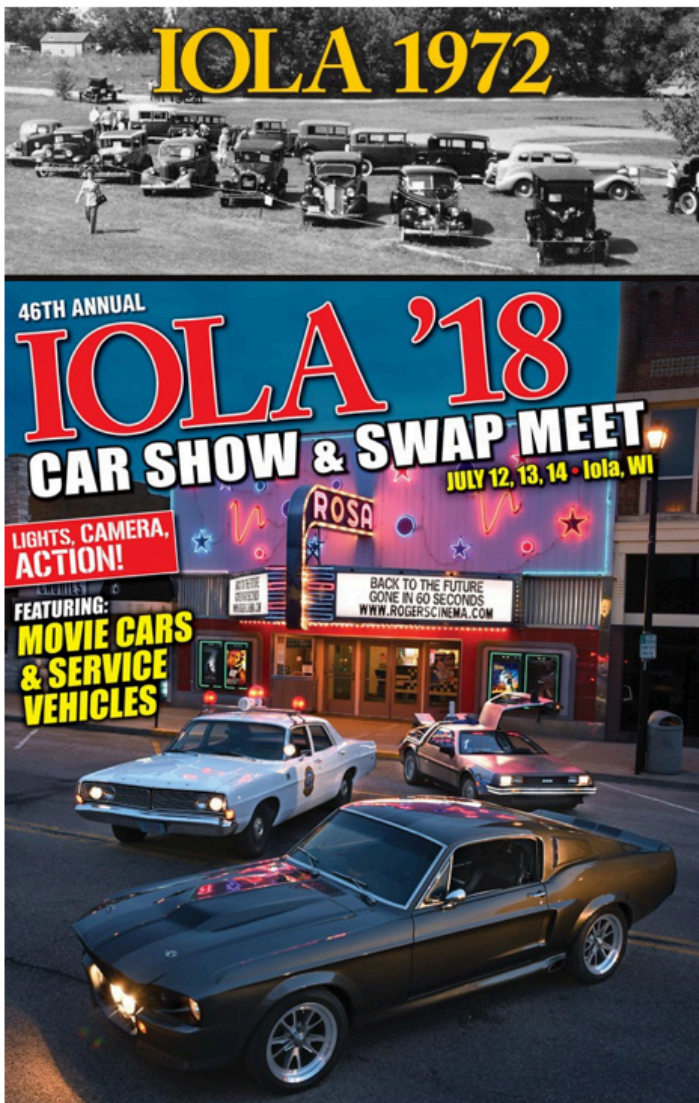
