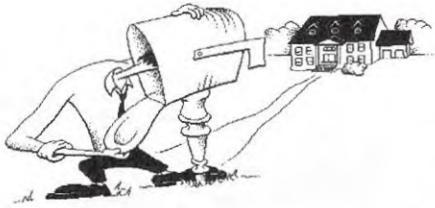
From the Prez.

## MINUTES FROM MEETING HELD JUNE 24TH

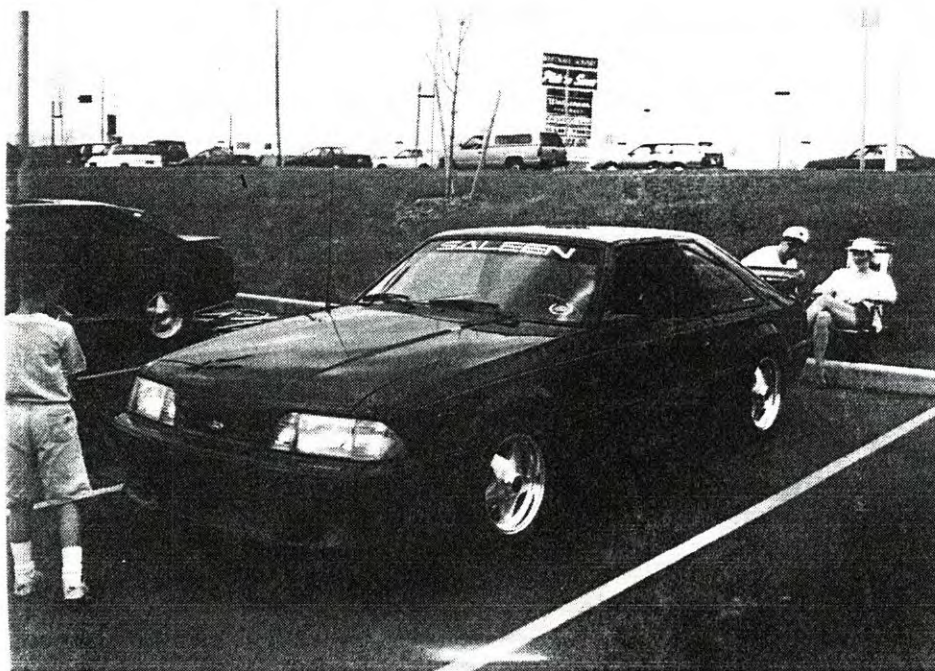
- The meeting was called to order at 7:30 by president Moen.
