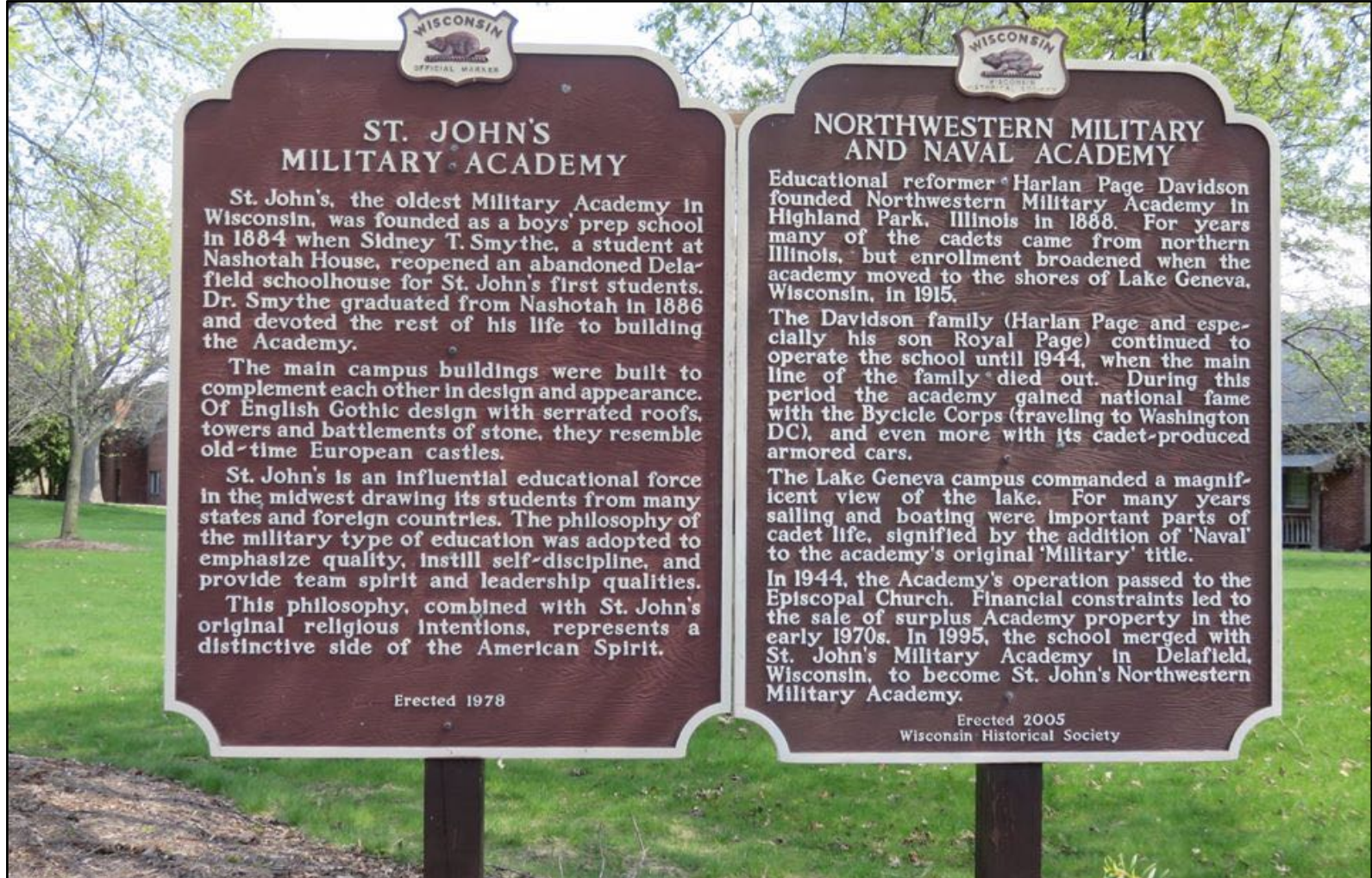


[Historical Marker Map](#)
