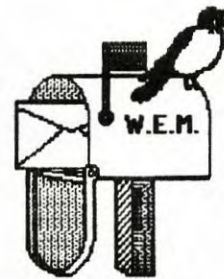

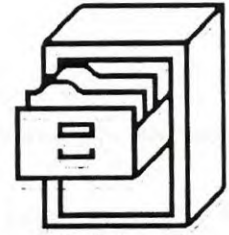

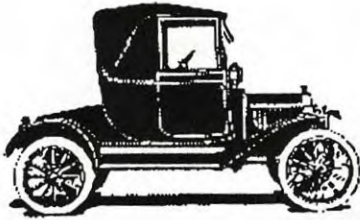


**1989 MUSTANG LX SPORT 5.0
OWNERS: CONNIE AND BOB TRIANTIFELO**

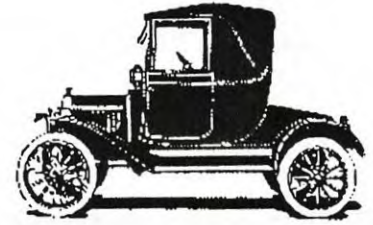

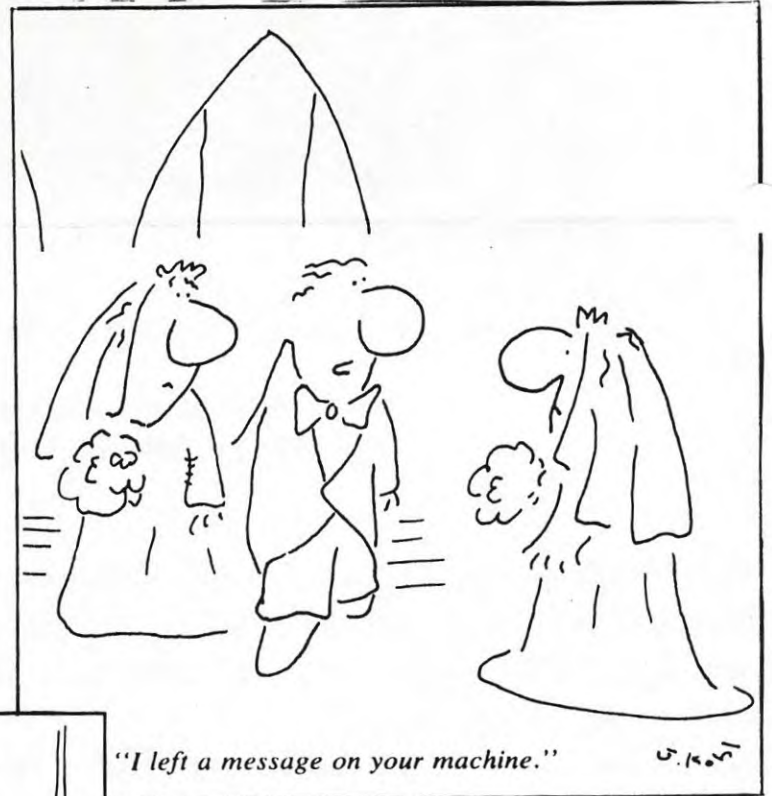

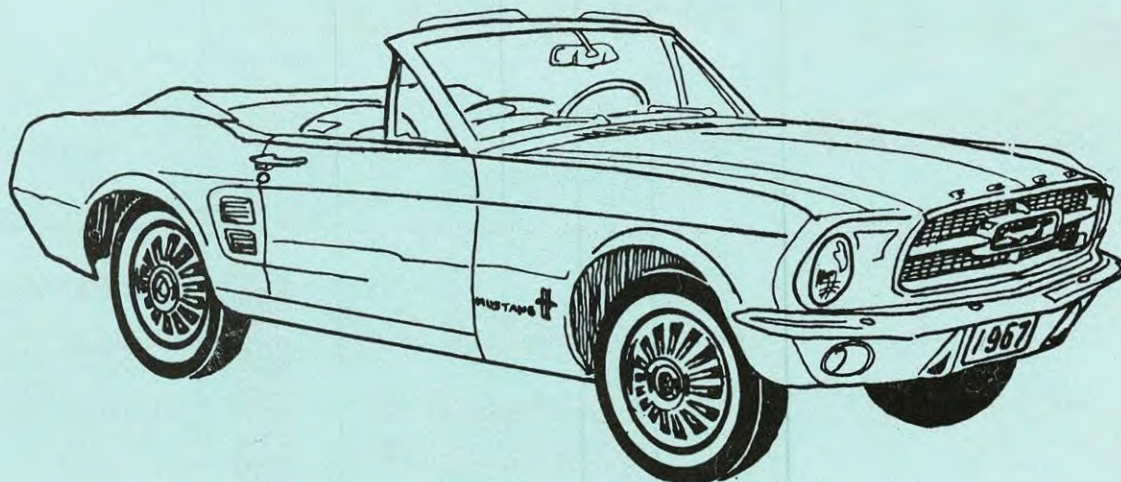
