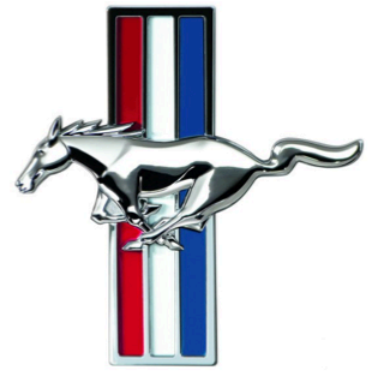

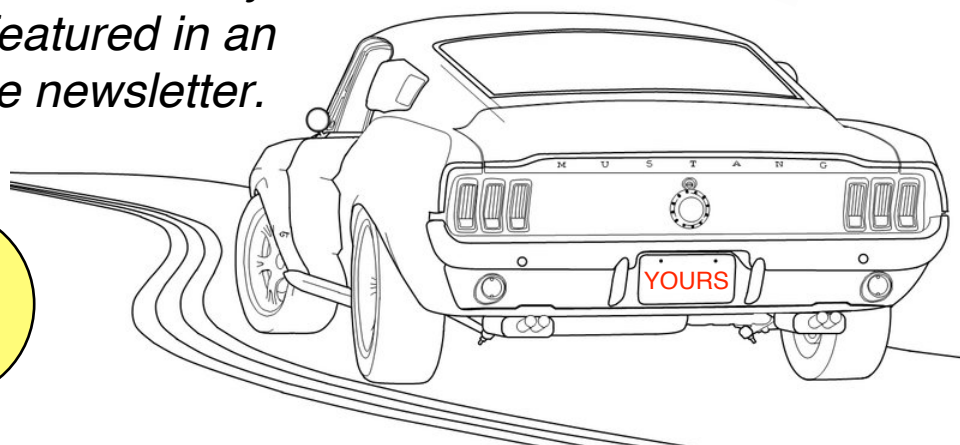

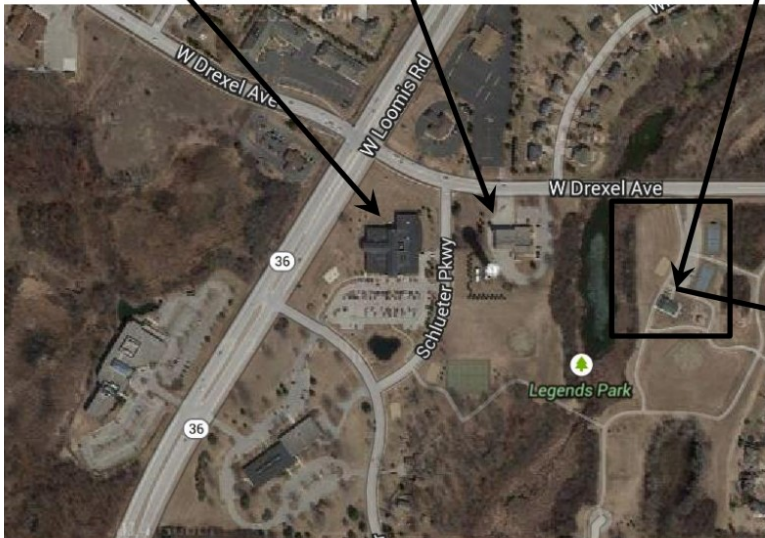

Clay Bar - Happy Hour



If the paint on your ride doesn't feel smooth as silk, even after a good wash and wax. It may need to be decontaminated with a clay bar. The clay bar removes embedded surface contamination like pollution, brake dust, industrial fallout, tree sap, road tar, light water spots, and other deeply-embedded debris. Anyone can use the clay bar to restore a smooth-as-glass feel to any automobile finish. Use the clay bar on any exterior paintwork, polished metal, glass, or clear optical plastic. The clay bar is easy to use: wash the car, then lubricate the area with a clay bar lube or quick detailer spray and scrub in long straight strokes with a clay bar until it feels smooth. Also available are synthetic clay bar substitutes for faster and easier clay bar decontamination process. Always follow manufactures instructions.

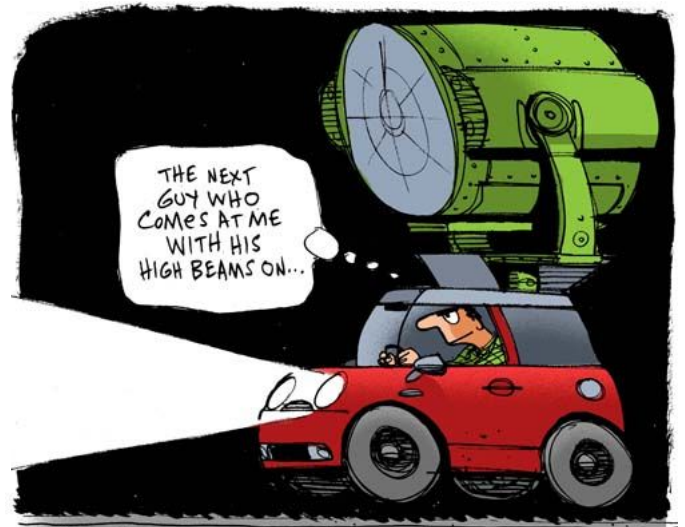
