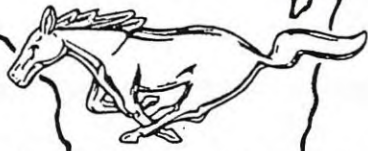

CAR OF THE MONTH

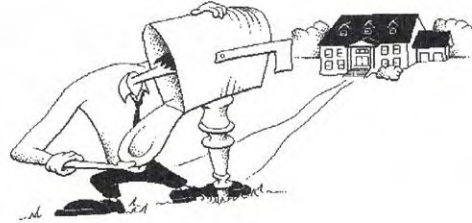

 - The meeting was adjourned at 8:00

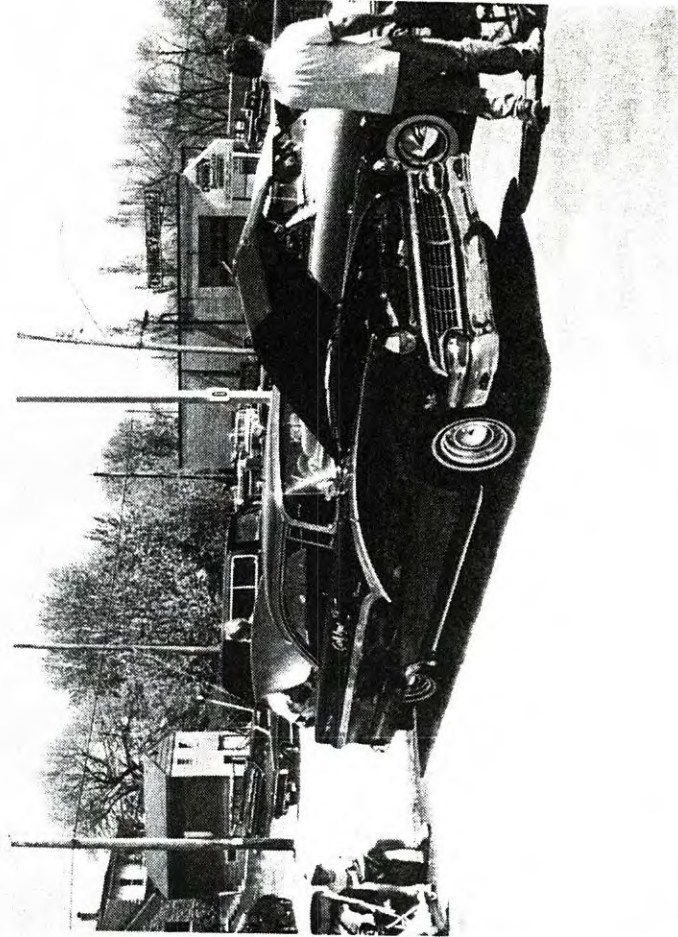
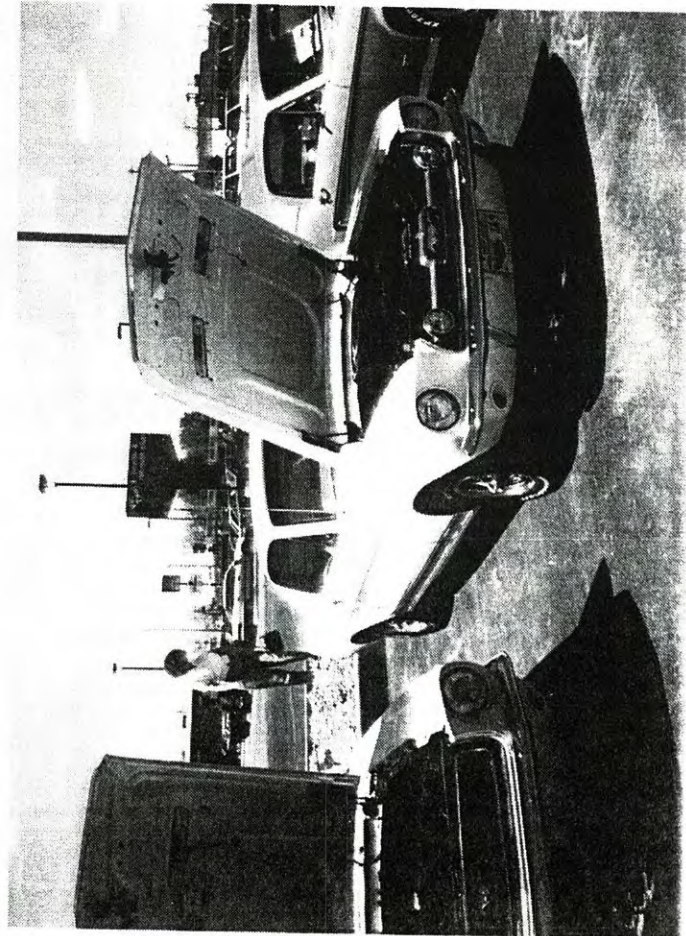
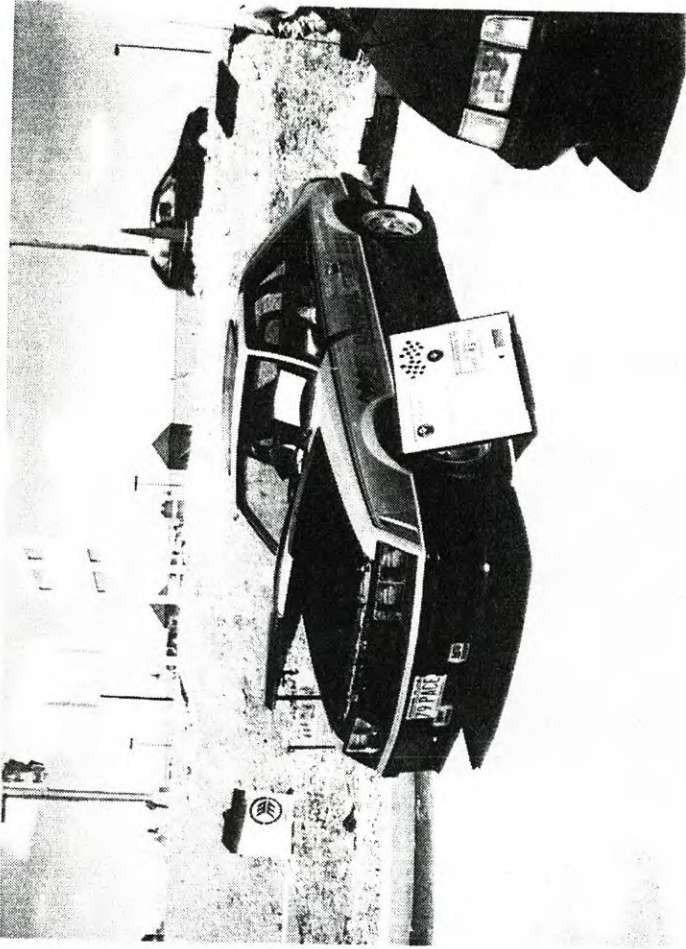
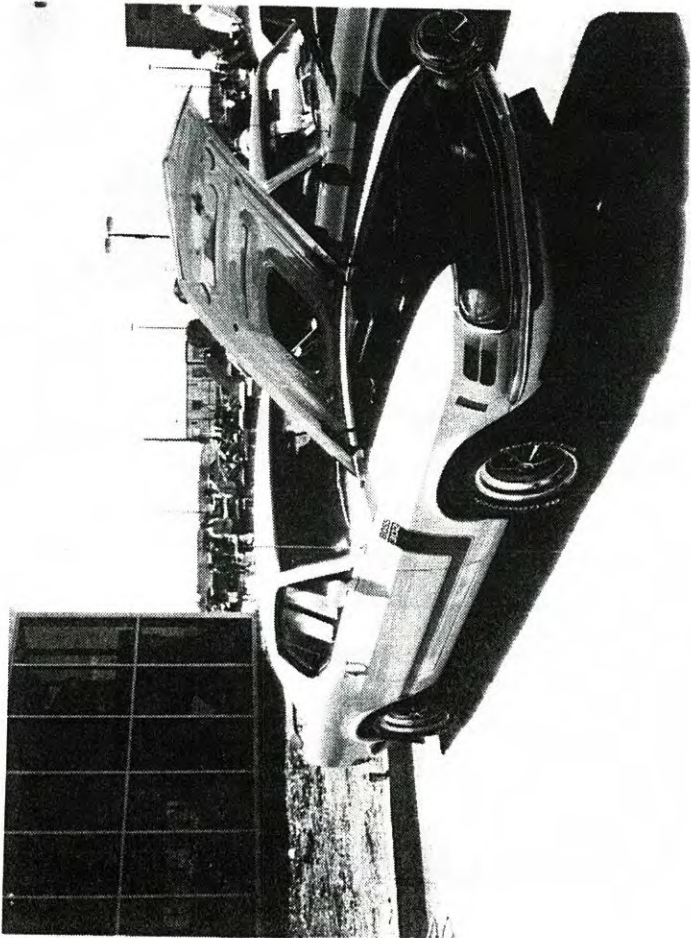
