**From the Prez.**

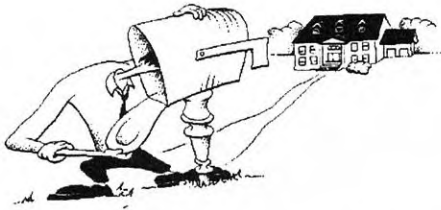
**September 28 , 1998**
