## **Tech Article**

**FORD BRAKE GREASE:** The ability to use petroleum based lubricating grease on Ford vehicle brake parts has been discontinued. This applies to all cars and trucks from the early 1980's to present. The reason is that petroleum based grease may be incompatible with EPDM rubber material used in the disc brake system and may cause parts to swell if they come in contact with this type of grease. The only material now approved for Ford vehicle disc brakes is Silicone Brake Caliper Grease and Dielectric compound (Ford part # D7AZ-19A331-A) or (Motorcraft # WA-10), Take note that Ford also specifies the use of this type of silicone compound on drum brake applications for lubricating duties between the brake shoe and backing plate contact points

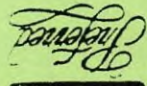
