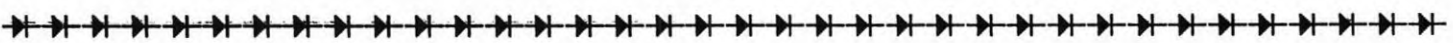

CAR OF THE MONTH



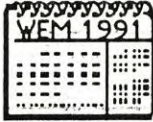
1965 MUSTANG CONVERTIBLE OWNER: EUGENE MYERS

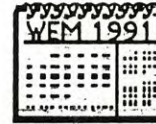
This '65 is equipped with power steering, air conditioning, 289 2BBL, dual exhaust system, and power top.
