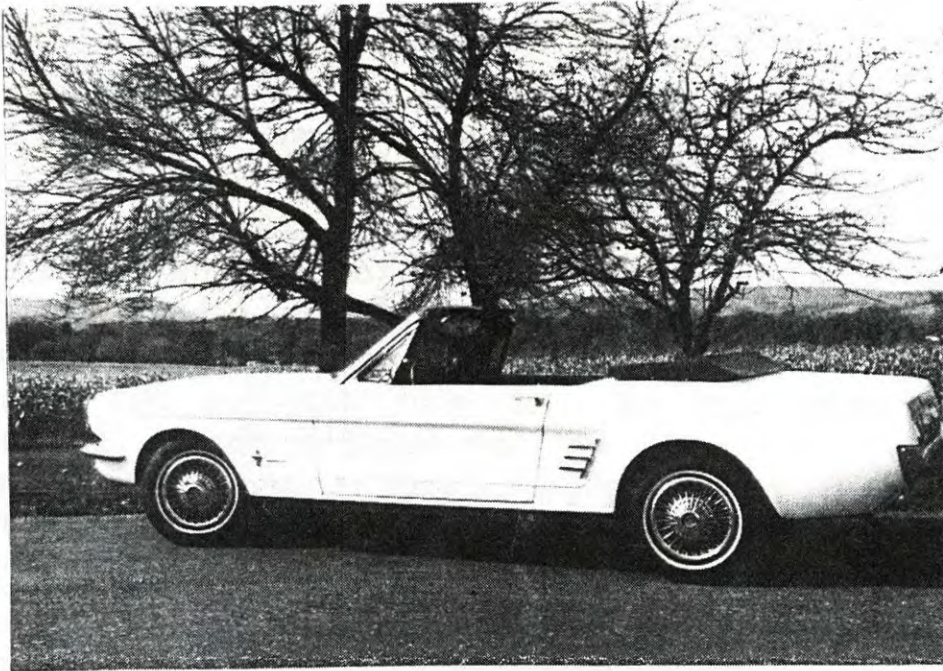

I wasn't exactly sure what to start off with, but seeing as the '94 Mustang is about to make it's debute on the 9th of December, why not start off with that. On November 6th I attended the Annual Model and Hobby show held in Chicago for the first time. My main mission was to see what new models were going to be released on the '94 Mustang and other Mustangs. Well I wasn't disappointed with what I saw. As I walked into the hall I was greeted by the Monogram / Revell booth. On display was the Mustang Mach III show car. They had their new '94 model kits on display. The new kits are as follows, (Please note that release dates are approximate.),

Over in the AMT / Ertl booth there was just as much activity. Along with their new models were the new Die-Casts they will have available. The models are as follows, (Again release dates are approximate.),

AMT/ Ertl will also be releasing two BOSS 302 Die-Casts in 1:18 scale and a 1:12 scale '65 Mustang Conv. Joeff Co. which makes Die-Cast vehicles, will be releasing a 1:18 scale Die-Cast '94 Mustang GT. This will be due out in late February, approx. I recently saw a catalog put out by Ford Motor Co. that had collectibles and accessories for the '94 Mustang. Everything from shirts and jacks to balloons and coffee mugs are going to be available to collectors. This included two '94 Mustang Promotional Models to be released in Mid 1994.
