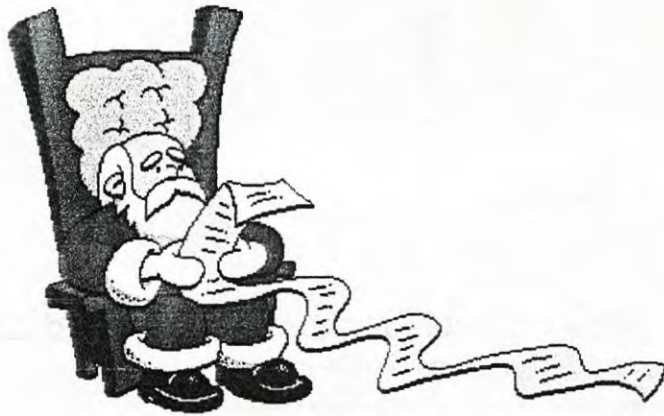

1998 Gimmick Bowling Outing

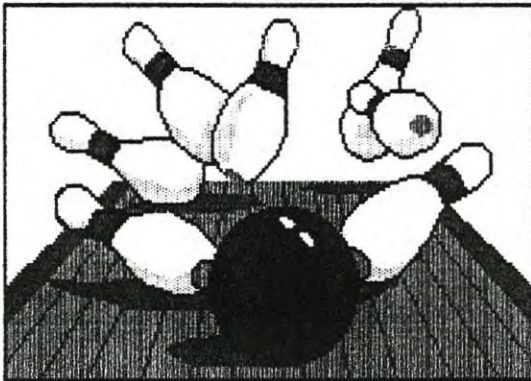
