<u>FYI</u> My modified 351-C has a Melling <u>high volume</u> oil pump. I found out the hard way that the stock 1/8" roll pin through the distributor gear is only marginally up to the task, and mine failed three times! When that pin shears, you stop! ...and loose pieces of the pin wind up in your oil pan! I finally got to talk with the right guy at Pertronix that said this is a fairly common problem with high volume oil pumps and the stock 1/8" roll pin. He had the gear and shaft drilled to accept a 3/16" pin at no additional charge in a new distributor. It's just basic physics that a larger displacement oil pump in an engine turning at 6-8000 RPM's vs. a stock displacement pump at 5500 RPM's is going to put a more strain on that pin, so **the solution is to install the 3/16" roll pin** which has about twice the shear strength, still retains the "fuse" feature of a roll pin should the oil pump seize, but the larger/stronger pin stays in one piece for reliable operation.

"Keep on 'stangin".




