## No December meeting to report on.

### **2015 Mustang Convertible Review and Comments** – from John Falkner

We *finally* got our new Mustang convertible on Saturday December 27th. As time passed, Griffin Ford arranged to have it drop shipped down to Matthews-Currie Ford in Florida for us. This took a lot of extra effort on the part of both Ford dealers, and it all worked out great ... due to many good people on both ends.

When we picked up the car, it was a knockout! They superbly prepped a flawless car from Ford ...I mean it was 100% perfect! Everything worked, not a blemish anywhere, all gaps, fit and finish were perfect. The only issue was that SYNC wasn't fully interactive with my new account for two days.

Driving the new 2015 Mustang is really where it gets interesting. Computers and electronics control virtually everything, including the "drive by wire" accelerator, so no matter how hard the pedal is pressed, acceleration is controlled by the computer. Different driving modes have different levels of traction control to limit wheel spin from a start with the 310 HP EcoBoost engine and six-speed auto/manual paddle shift transmission for whatever you want. However, I didn't buy this car for the drag strip, but for normal day-today driving, and it is great in the default normal mode. Even though this is the new 2.3 L version, it's similar to other EcoBoost engines with plenty of smooth power, and the new twin scroll turbo seems to eliminate any turbo lag often mentioned with these engines. It's just a very smooth power that doesn't seem

Our car has the performance package which upgrades the all new suspension, tires and wheels, brakes, and rear axle ratio, so our car rides and handles like a dream, plus handles corners unbelievably flat and fast. The convertible top operation is even faster and easier than I expected. Just pull down one handle at the top's front center, give it a quarter twist, and push the top down button, and a few seconds later, the top is

down. This new electric mechanism is really as fast and slick as advertised. And the trunk is huge! I could go on for days about this car and its great features, so feel free to call with any questions if you're thinking of getting one, because our car is exactly what I hoped for. About the only problem is that all this refinement, quality, and features do come at a price. The Mustang is no longer a cheap econobox like my '71, but features like SYNC, voice activated navigation, adaptive cruise, performance package,

premium sound with Sirius radio, etc. bring the '15 Mustang to a whole new level of AWESOME!
