- 2. Dawn Raduechel will design the flyer. Theme of show yet to be decided by Dick Doria.
- 3. Dawn Raduechel will be responsible for show publicity.
- 4. Joan & Jeff Searing will print and mail flyers. They will get past years' information from Bob Zimmermann and screen past mailings to attempt to reduce mailing costs. Members will receive the show flyer in the newsletter.
- 5. Vern Snyder will procure the music and food vendors. Will attempt to get contract with music vendor in writing.
- 6. Dick Doria will check on the time for setup on Saturday with Ewald Ford.
- 7. Sal Lorino will again be in charge of the Club's swap booth.
- 8. Dick and Sharon Doria will be in charge of the Club's table.
- 9. Scott Moen and Don Schultz will be in charge of parking this year. Parking attendants should be at the show at 6:30 AM on Sunday. Cell phones were helpful last year and a list of the cell phone numbers for the parking attendants will be made available by Scott Moen prior to the show.




