? Wisconsin Collector Plates ?

Have you been interested in "Collector" plates for your car? I had my bone stock survivor Mustang and bought "Collector" plates as soon as it was 20-years-old because it was a one-time purchase saving money on future registrations AND eliminated the need for the annual emission inspections. Since then, I made significant modifications to the driveline and suspension, and worried about being caught with "Collector" plates, instead of "Hobbyist" plates, but I can now relax with the DMV/DOT news release below. Wisconsin Act 103 is a series of statutory changes signed into law by Governor Walker that go into effect on March 1. The changes have a significant impact on collector plate eligibility and remove barriers to registering former military vehicles. Under previous law to qualify for a collector plate the vehicle had to be 20 years old and <u>not</u> been altered or modified from the original manufacturers specifications.

Act 103 alters the originality requirement for collector plates. **The requirement now reads the body has not been altered from the original.** In the past, DMV would not issue a collector plate for a vehicle that we recognized had interior modifications, engine modifications, wheel changes etc. All such changes **will now be allowed, provided the body has not been altered.**
