New '15 Stuff - - - Adaptive Cruise Control

A year ago, I had never heard of adaptive cruise, but would never get a new car without it now. So what is it, how does it work, and why does it cost so much? Everyone is familiar with standard cruise control, but it's almost useless in traffic. This is where the adaptive cruise is awesome, and the major difference. It senses the vehicle in front of you, and automatically maintains at least a desired gap to the vehicle in front of you.

Sensors in front of your car sense vehicles (cars, trucks, motorcycles, even bicycles) in front of you **in your lane, and the distance to that vehicle**. You set the speed like on a normal cruise, but also set your minimum desired gap between vehicles with one to four bars showing on the dash display. A computer controls and adjusts your speed up to the maximum set speed. If the vehicle in front slows below your set speed, your vehicle automatically also slows to maintain the same safe gap between vehicles ... all the way down to almost fully stopped. It takes a little getting used to, but really makes "in traffic" driving a breeze.
