### GENTLEPERSONS, START YOUR ENGINES!

### A proposal by John Slusar

Our new Club President expressed an interest in organizing a race track event this year, to celebrate the great success of our favorite car. As a member of the Vintage Sports Car Drivers Association, I have driven my own vintage race car on the tracks at Elkhart Lake and Blackhawk Farms, near South Beloit, IL. Blackhawk is an especially nice venue, best compared to our own beautiful Grant Park. Turns out that the Northwoods Shelby Club will be hosting its Track Day there on August 27-28, this year. (same date as The Masterpiece Show) We approached their President with a proposal to bring a Caravan of Mustangs to their event and were greeted with open arms. What a natural pairing, an opportunity not to be missed: Early Mustangers and the Shelby Club.

As "special guests", we will be treated to a real "insider's look at racing", even including an opportunity to tour the 2-mile track for about 5-7 laps! Entry to the event is FREE, but those who drive on the track must pay \$25 per car, which is ultra-cheap. We will be required to run at least 15 cars on the track, since safety personnel must be stationed there, so I will be looking for firm commitments between now and August 1. I will circulate a sign-up sheet at our Monthly Meetings and other events. Paced speed will be no higher than 60 mph, no RACING or ANTICS allowed. You will feel like a real racer, when you attend the Mandatory Drivers Meeting,





a "chalk talk" about the track and its rules, to be held in the modern Pavilion, just before we start our Track Tour. (All of the buildings are clean and modern, and the Rest Room building was designed and built by Kohler...definitely NOT a METRO UNIT!). Following our laps, we will meet at the covered Concession Stand, for lunch, around 1PM. They serve until 3PM. Racing heats are scheduled from 8AM to 6PM. You will basically have the "run" of the Paddock, the inner part of the race track, and using common safety sense and polite manners, you can walk right up to the cars being prepared for the track and talk to the owners and drivers. Those who can stay will be invited to a FREE Brat Fry, starting at 5:30PM, hosted by the Shelby Club. I will provide participants with instructions to drive to the track, so you are free to travel on your own schedule.

I saved something special for last. One of my favorite aspects of the Blackhawk experience is that they allow FREE Camping. This is a very wooded place, and those who want to be kids again, (Don't we all??) can set up a tent and stare at the stars, or sit around on folding chairs, chatting with their Mustang friends. I will be bringing my little 4X8 Teardrop Trailer and a large EZ-Up for all to use. If you have a little tent to pitch and/or an EZ-up of your own, I'm thinking that this could be a memorable event. Some of you know that I announced this plan at the January Meeting, to test the waters, and that just about everybody in the room encouraged me to go forward with the plan. In fact, two of our members have already said they will stay overnight. I'm hoping this will be contagious. So, if that spark of youth is still flickering in you, please consider bringing a tent along, even if you have to borrow one from your kids. The Concession also serves breakfast, so the Overnighters might consider staying also for Sunday, which has an identical Racing Schedule (No Tours or Brat Fry.)


