BLACKHAWK FARMS EVENT by John Slusar Saturday, August 27th 2016

We have so much ground to cover today, that I have dispensed with photos, to fit in the facts and figures. However, to satisfy your optic nerves, please follow this link to a video made from an 8mm film of a 1982 Blackhawk race featuring a 1970 Mach 1: https://youtu.be/Rjp9Xk5Bsk0

As you know from our previously published proposal, this driving event will feature a colorful caravan of our cars from a meeting place at Hwy 164 on the Rock Freeway to the raceway, located in South Beloit, just over the Illinois border, a distance of about 60 miles of easy driving. Our schedule is jampacked, and well-described in the proposal letter, which has appeared in our last four Newsletters. I asked our membership to send me any questions, and I received only one, but it is a very important one, and I am using this opportunity to address it in detail. "Full disclosure", as they say.

My plan includes a generous offer from our hosts, the Northwoods Shelby Club, to give us an opportunity to experience up to five laps on the track, driving at controlled speeds, following their pace car, single file, with no passing. Such "parade laps" are common at racing venues, and are *relatively* safe for participants. Besides seat belts, no special equipment, driving suits or helmets are required. However, it must be clearly understood that participation in any inner track events and particularly driving on the track surface is always done at the complete risk of the participant drivers and their passengers. When we enter the track property, we are required to sign a standard Waiver of Liability. In effect, you are "signing your life away". The entire risk of personal liability for life and property, including damage to the track itself, is your own.

In my experience, I have seen large numbers of drivers using their own street vehicles to take part in such paced laps at venues such as Road America and Blackhawk Farms during non-racing periods, such as during the Noon lunch breaks. But these are typically serious race enthusiasts who have no problem with signing the waivers and taking the risks. I realize that in our case, most of our members have never been closer to the track than the grandstand or the outer parking lot. With that in mind, I have spent many days contacting insurance companies and speaking with their underwriters about coverages for both "street-driven" and "collector" cars, including American Family, Liberty Mutual and Progressive, plus Grundy, Heacock, JC Taylor and Hagerty. Excepting a "possibility" at JC Taylor, absolutely no company allows any coverages to extend to track property. I also contacted a specialty insurance company called "K and K", which writes custom policies that could cover us, but which require GROUP coverage (no single car policies) with large premiums and \$2000 deductibles. In short, nothing realistic or practical, for a mere 30 minutes on the track.

All of that said, I feel that we should try to determine if we can field the minimum required fifteen cars from among our group to be involved in this paced tour activity. Between now and a deadline of July 31, 2016, I am asking those who are willing, to send me a check for \$25 for their car entry. If I receive 15 prepaid entries, we will go forward with the paced laps; if not, I will remove that offering from our menu and return all checks. (Please use the form below)

Please note that none of the above has anything to do with the rest of the day's plans. Everything else in the "proposal" is still in place and FREE OF CHARGE, including Paddock entry, the use of all facilities, the Brat Fry and the overnight camping.

Be sure to mark your calendars for Saturday, August 27, (Rain Date August 28) to take part in this FREE ROAD TRIP. Read over the proposal description and get fired up over our Club's first-ever track event, featuring an "INSIDER'S" view and a fun overnight camping opportunity.


SIGN-UP FORM FOR PARTICIPATION IN BLACKHAWK FARMS PACED LAPS


