🐾 Milwaukee Firefighters Museum (7/27): Gary Fedder passed around a sign up sheet.



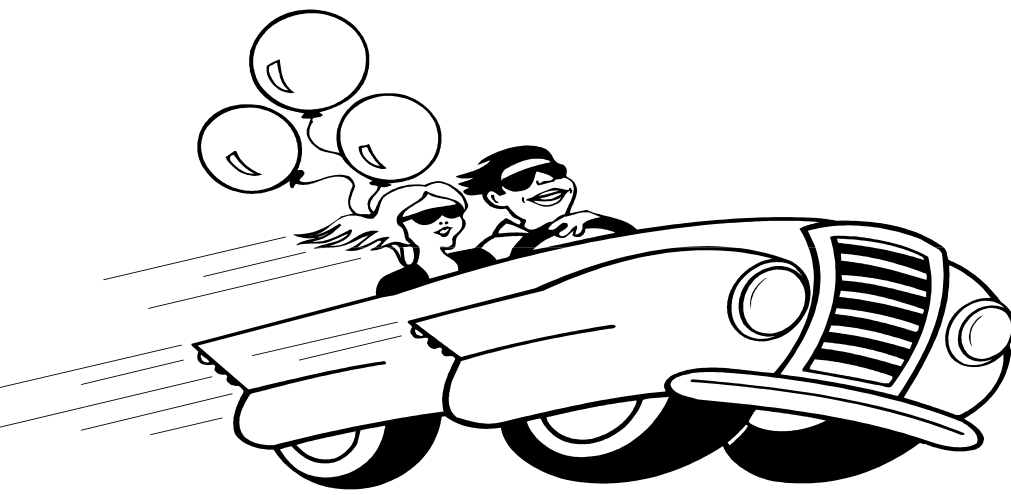
WEM Annual Picnic
