ELECTRICAL TRAINING FOR THE MUSTANGER

If you are like most other automotive hobbiests, you are somewhat frightened by the magical phenomena known as electricity. We will attempt to belay some of those fears for you in the next few months. This stuff will be pretty simple, but still will give a good foundation for doing some of your own electrical troubleshoot -ing. You will be amazed at the amount of electrical work which can be done with a few good jumper (test) leads and a twelve volt test light. Common sense goes a long way too.

Useable electrical energy is found in two states, alternating current (such as your household wall plug) and direct current , such as your car or flashlight battery. We will be concentrating on the direct variety, which by the way is easier in most part to work with. No matter what type you are working with, always remember that to do a job, electricity must have a completed path called a circuit.

Think of your cars battery as a little powerhouse. For the purpose of discussion, it sends power from the POSITIVE (+) Terminal. The power then follows part of the circuit (wires) to the job location (light, horn, radio etc.). If the circuit is complete it then follows what we call the ground path back to the NEGATIVE (-) Terminal. If any part of the circuit is not complete the desired device will not operate. This of course includes wires, fuses, all connections, the device itself and of course the battery.

Next month we'll set up some common examples of failures or malfunctions and tell you the systematic approach to troubleshooting. Until then, think "complete circuit paths".


