The Meeting Continued

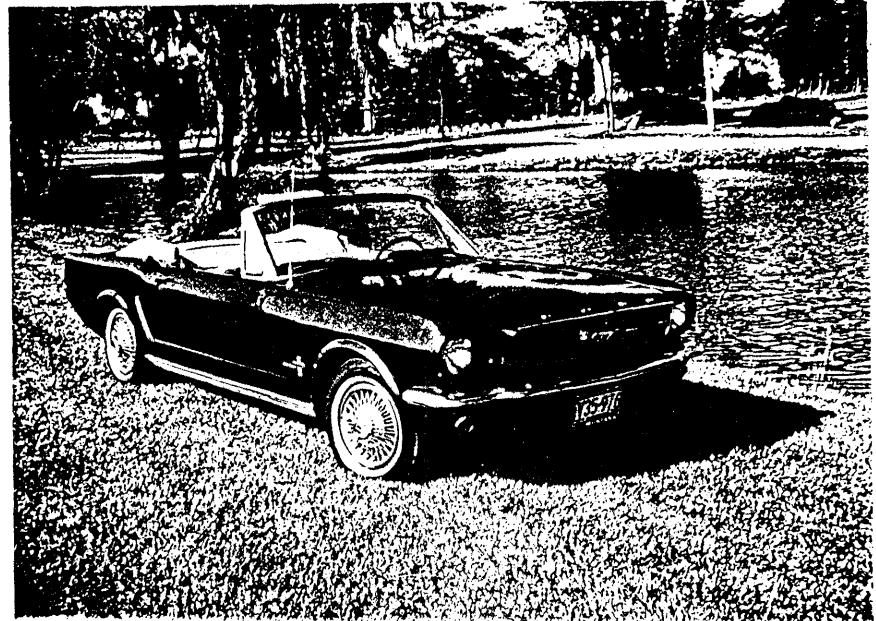
