



Diagnosing Engine Noises

Piston Ring Noise


Clicking noise during acceleration.

Common Causes: Low ring tension, broken rings, worn cylinder walls.

Valvetrain Noise

Regular clicking noise at half-speed.

> Common Causes: Excessive valve clearance, defective lifter:



Piston Slap

Continuous muffled, hollow sound.

Common Causes: Excessive piston-to-wall clearance, worn cylinders, inadequate oil.



Detonation

High-pitched metallic noise (pinging).

Common Causes: Improper timing, lean air/fuel ratio, improper octane.

Crankshaft Knock

Heavy, yet dull metallic knock under load.

Common Causes:

Worn bearings; main, rod,

or thrust.

Piston Pin Noise

Metallic, double knock at idle.

Common Causes: Worn or loose piston pin, worn bushing, inadequate oil.



Connecting Rod Noise

Light knocking or pounding sound.

Common Causes: Misaligned rod, inadequate oil, worn bearing or crankpin.




